





## DESIGN FOR A PORTABLE CONTAINER FOR LIQUIDS

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Lieutenant Colonel William B. Johnson, Quartermaster Corps, United States Army, Holabird Quartermaster Depot, Baltimore, Maryland, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Portable Container for Liquids, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a portable container for liquids showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is an end elevational view thereof.

Fig. 3 is a plan view thereof.

The dominant features of my design reside in the portions shown in full lines.
