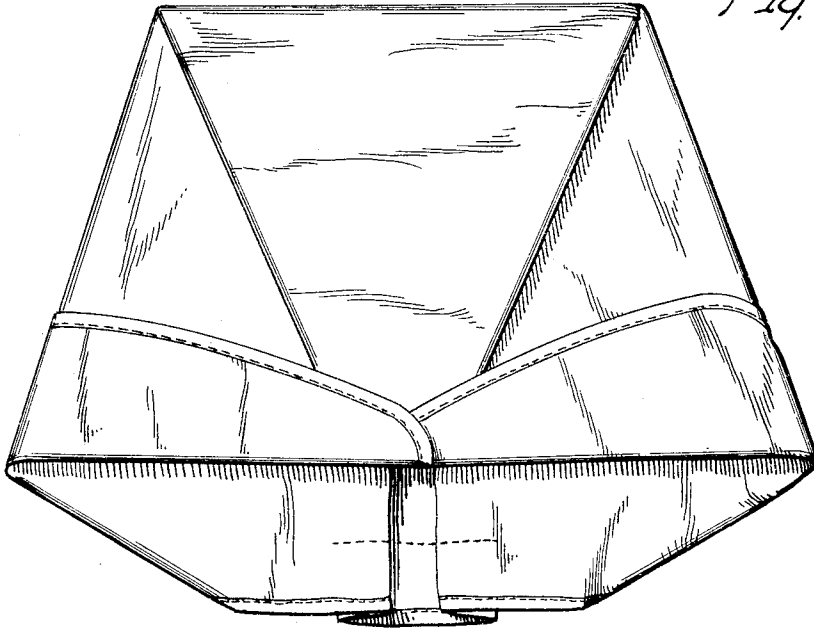
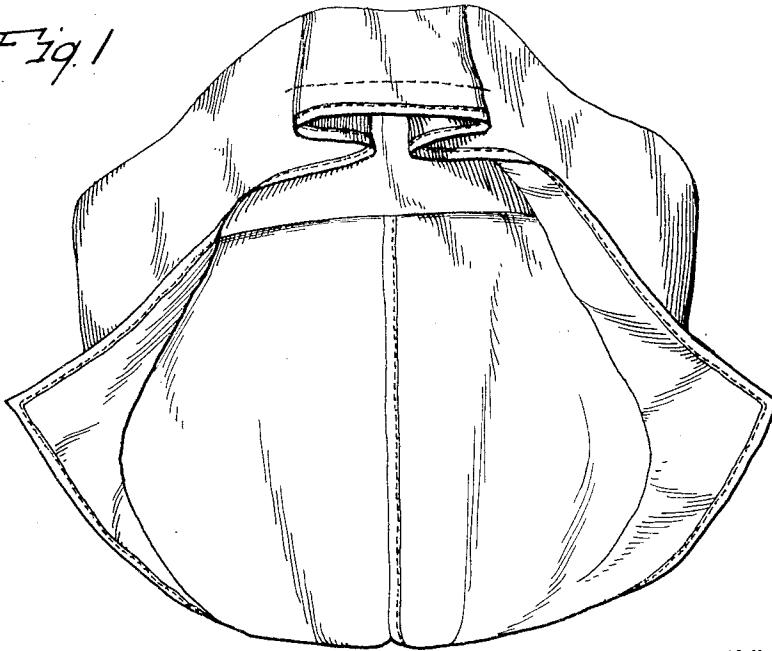

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NELL F. WINGET, a citizen of the United States, residing at Minneapolis, in the county of Hennepin and State of Minnesota, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Cap or Bonnet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
