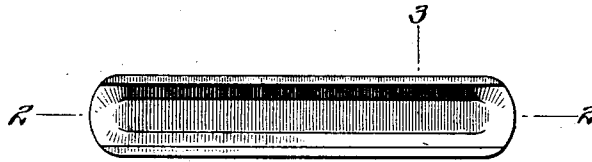

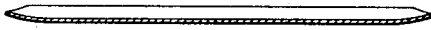

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LEO D. JACOBY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new and original and ornamental Design for Tongue-Depressors, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

In the drawings Figure 1 is a plan view of a tongue depressor embodying my new design; Fig. 2 is a section on line 2—2 of Fig. 1; Fig. 3 is section on line 2—2 of Fig. 1.
