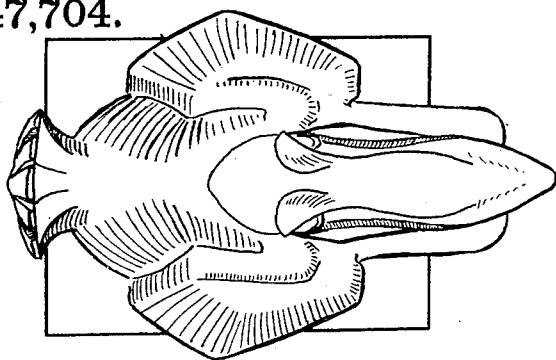

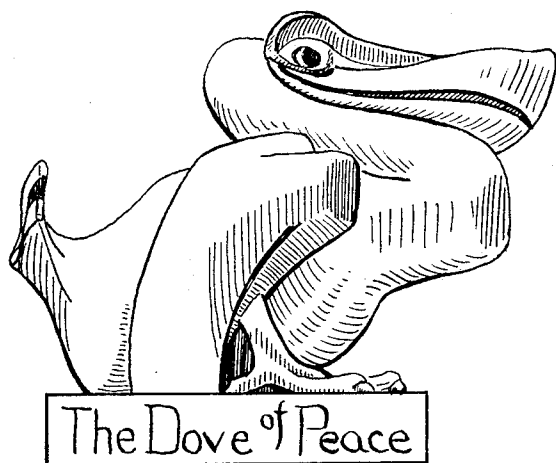

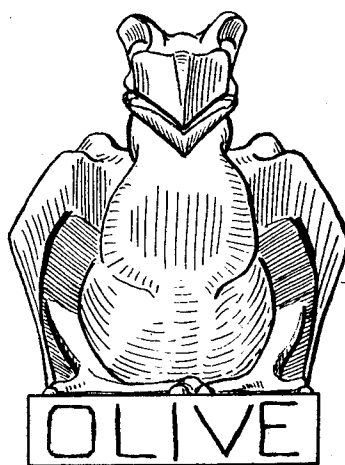

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MORGAN STINEMETZ, a citizen of the United States, residing at Washington, in the District of Columbia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Statuettes, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
