

DESIGN FOR CARPET.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 24,049, dated February 19, 1895.

Application filed December 15, 1894. Serial No. 531,984. Term of patent 31/2 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ARTHUR MIDDLETON ROSE, residing at Yonkers, county of Westchester, State of New York, have invented and

- 5 produced a new and original Design for a Pattern to be Wrought into Wilton and other Carpetings in such coloring as may be designed; and I do hereby declare that the drawing accompanying this specification gives and
- 10 conveys to any one skilled in the art of carpet weaving and manufacture a clear understanding of the same, and is sufficient to enable such person to use my invention.

The design consists of a body A. and a bor-15 der B. The body A is decorated with flowers of the lily type arranged so as to cover nearly all of the background. The border B is decorated with corresponding flowers appearing at intervals in scroll work.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for carpets, consisting of the body A, and the border B, substantially as shown.
