*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Eugenie J. Jones, a citizen of the United States, residing at Webster Groves, State of Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Sheet of Stationery or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
