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[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handset telephone base, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a handset telephone base showing our new design, where the bottom surface, not shown, is plain and unadorned and the top end and right side, neither shown, are mirror images, respectively, of the shown bottom end and left side;

FIG. 2 is a top front perspective view of a second modified embodiment of the handset telephone base illustrated in FIG. 1, where the right side, not shown, is a mirror image of the shown left side;

FIG. 3 is a top rear view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation of a third modified embodiment of the handset telephone base illustrated in FIG. 1; the left side elevation is a mirror image of the side shown; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom front perspective view thereof where the top surface, not shown, is identical to the top surface shown in FIG. 1 and the top end and right side, not shown, are mirror images, respectively, of the shown bottom end and left side.

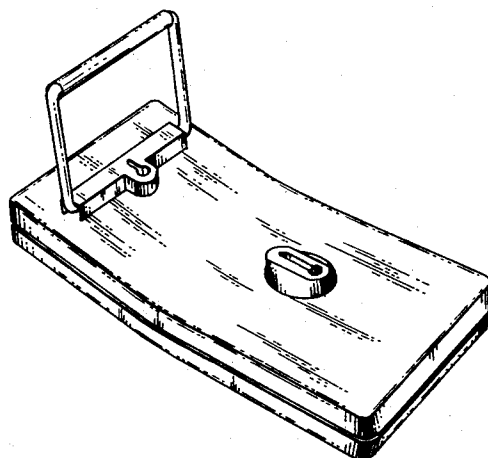
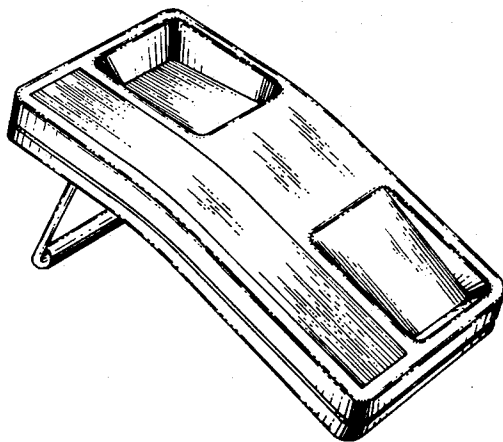

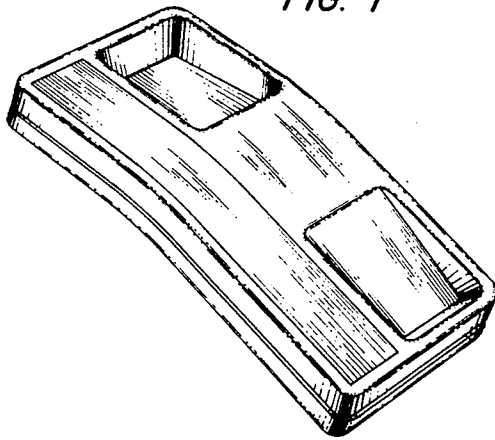

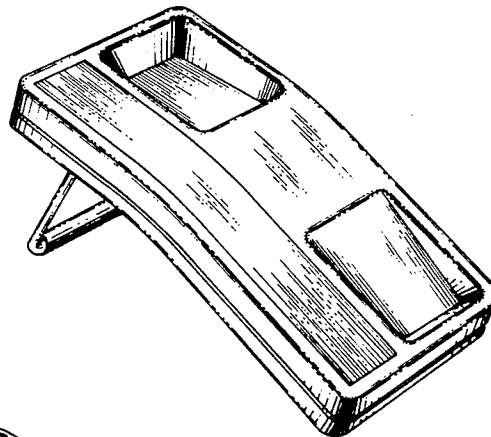

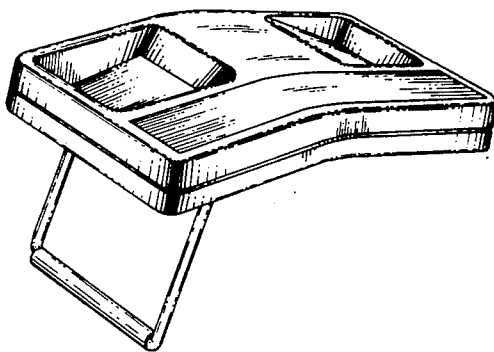

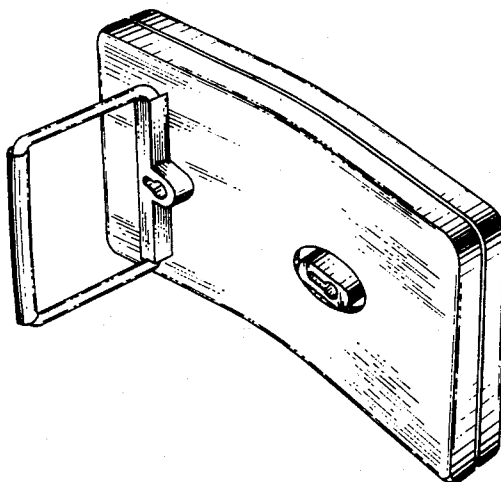

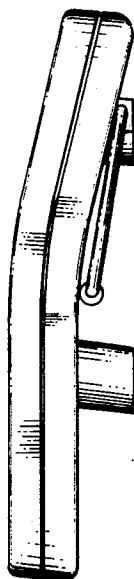
