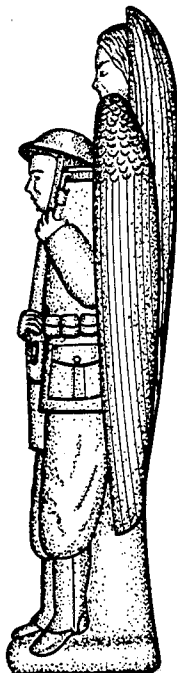

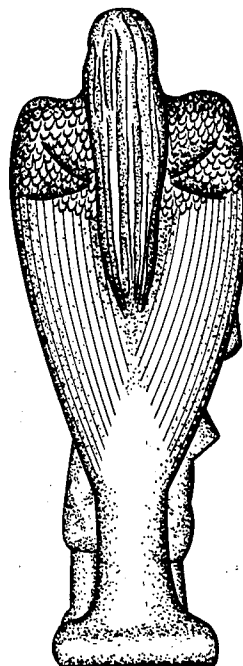

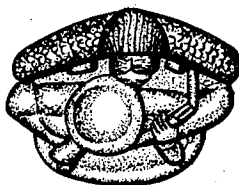

## DESIGN FOR A STATUETTE

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Nicholas Falardo, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Statuette, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a statuette, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view.

Fig. 3 is a rear elevational view; and
