

12. The method of claim 11, wherein the botulinum toxin is selected from the group consisting of types A, B, C, D, E, and, G.
13. A method of treating incontinence associated with sexual activity comprising
 - a) administering a therapeutically effective amount of a botulinum toxin to the bladder of a patient in need thereof, and;
 - b) administering a therapeutically effective amount of an anticholinergic drug to a patient in need thereof;thereby treating the incontinence associated with sexual activity.
14. The method of claim 13, wherein the botulinum toxin is selected from the group consisting of types A, B, C, D, E, and, G.
15. The method of claim 14, wherein the botulinum toxin is type A or type B.
