

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Frank Morrow, a citizen of the United States, residing at Johnston, in the county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for a Finding for Pins or Similar Articles of Jewelry, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a finding for pins or similar articles of jewelry showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a side view thereof.
