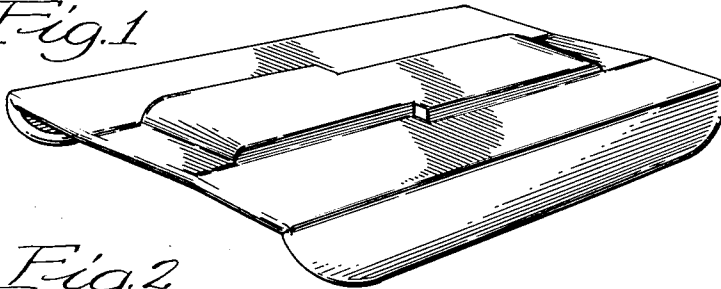

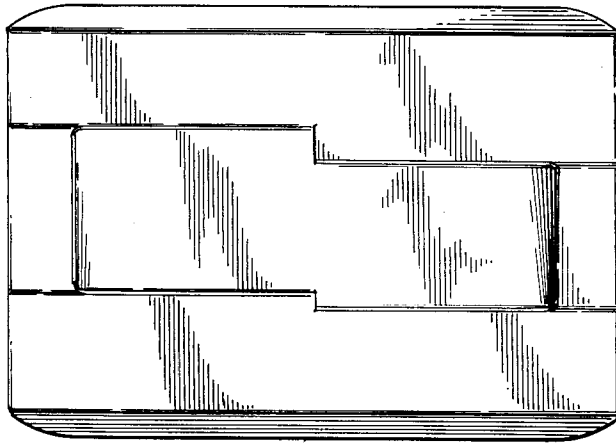


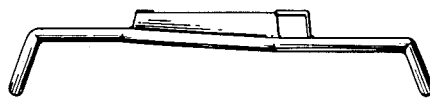

DESIGN FOR A VEGETABLE CUTTER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James A. Murdock, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vegetable Cutter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a vegetable cutter embodying my new design.

Fig. 2 is a plan view thereof.

Fig. 3 is a side elevation thereof.

Fig. 4 is an end elevation thereof looking from the left hand side of Fig. 3.

Fig. 5 is an end elevation thereof looking from the right hand side of Fig. 3.
