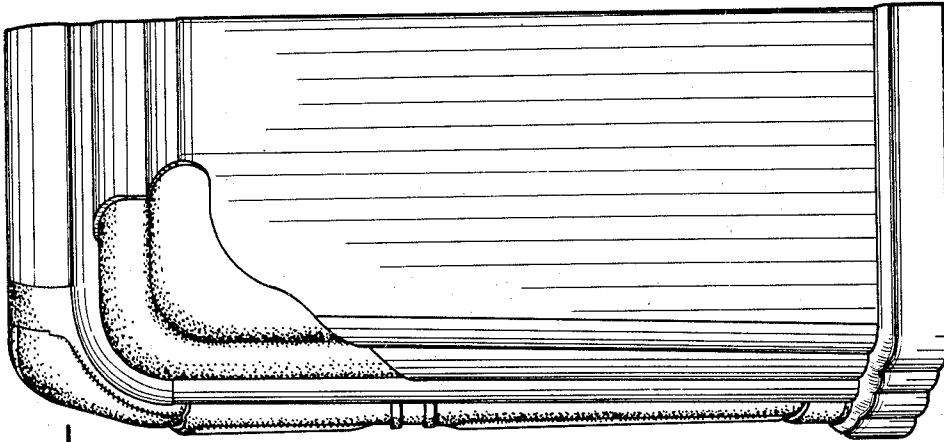

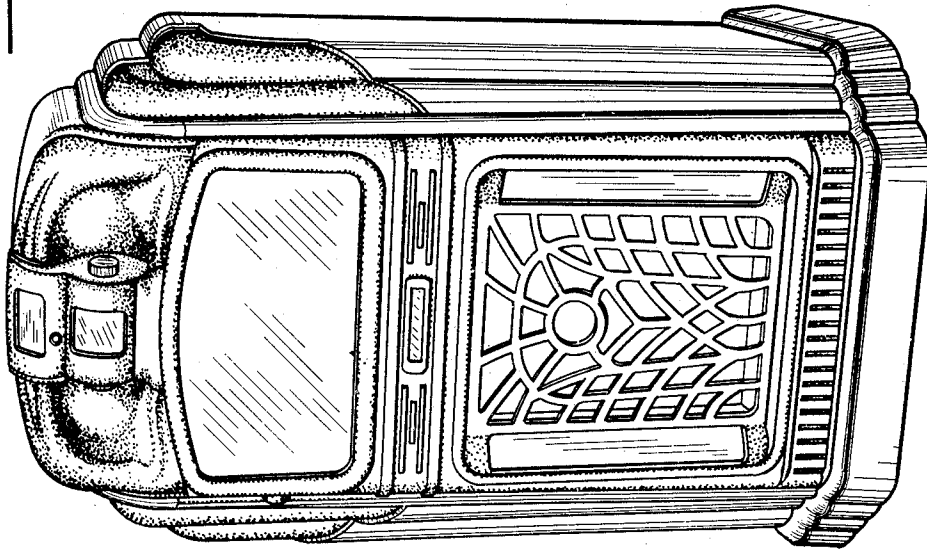

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert L. Ardner, a citizen of the United States, residing at Indianapolis, in the county of Marion and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Phonograph Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

In the drawings, Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of a phonograph cabinet, showing my new design; and Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.

Both sides of the phonograph cabinet are the same, as shown in Fig. 2.
