[57] **CLAIM**

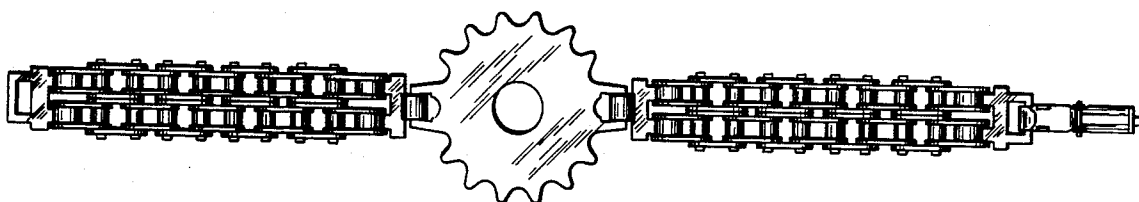
The ornamental design for a bracelet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bracelet showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an edge elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof, the links being continuous over the area indicated by dot-dash lines are omitted for ease of illustration.



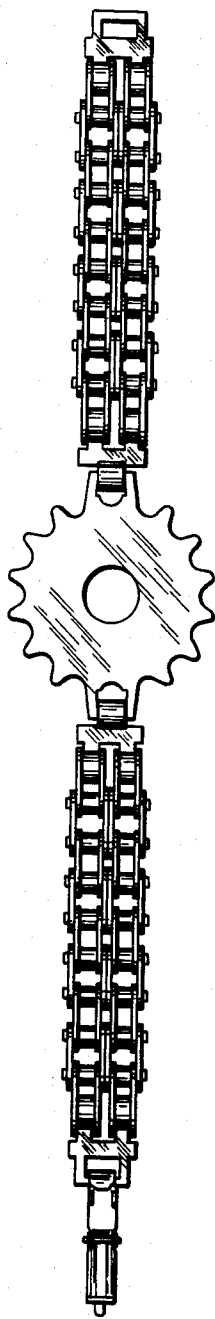

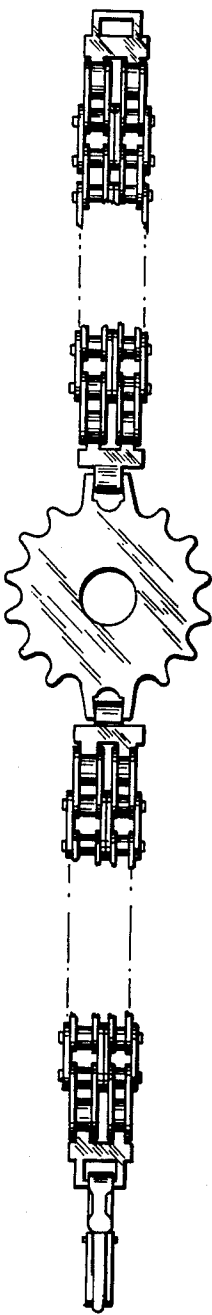
