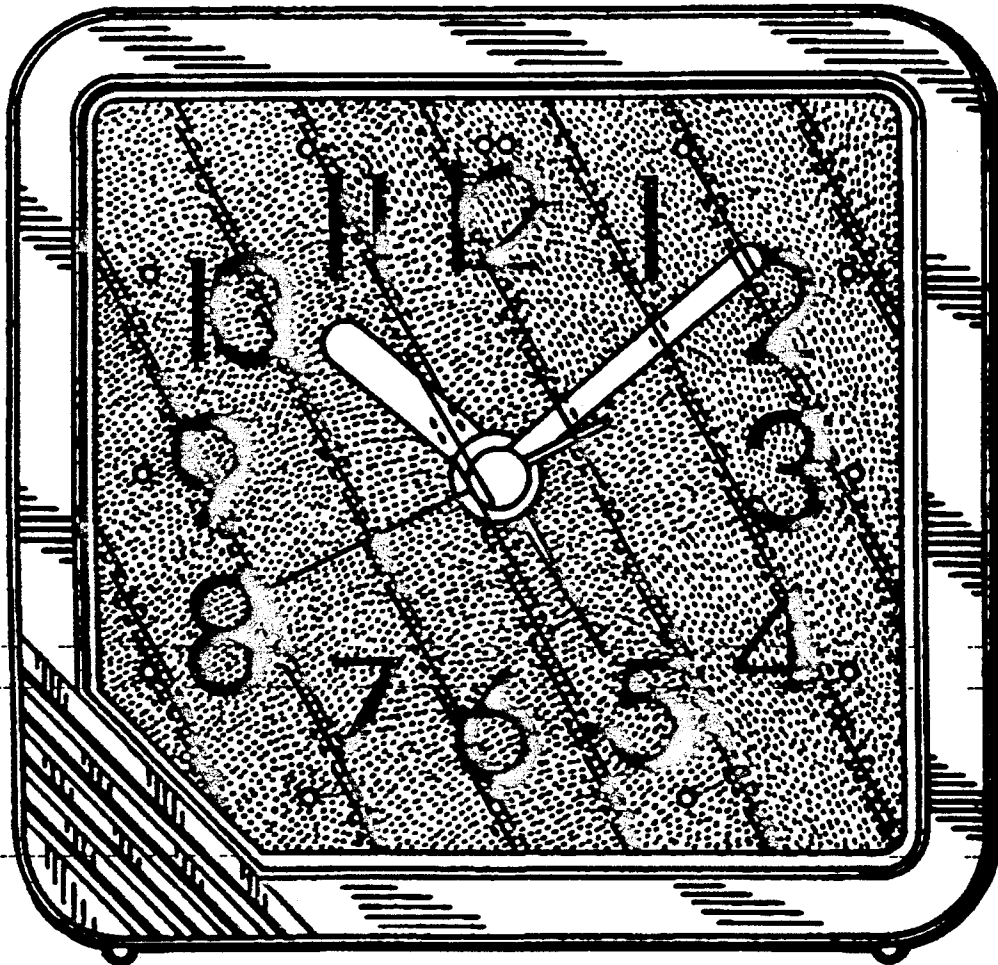

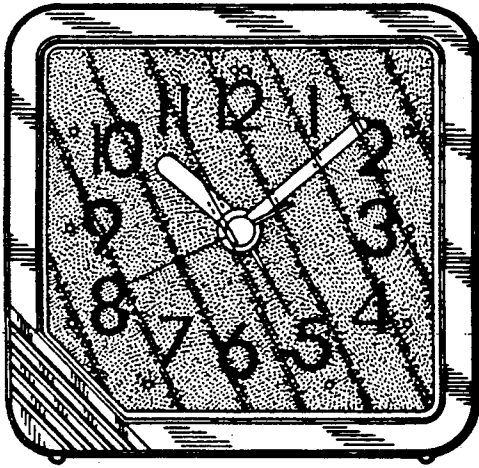
[57] The ornamental design for a clock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

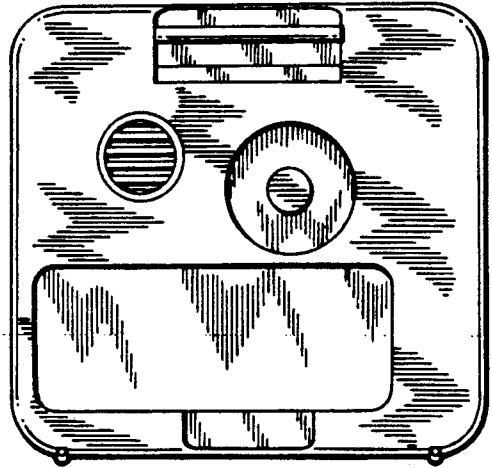
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock showing my new design;

 FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.



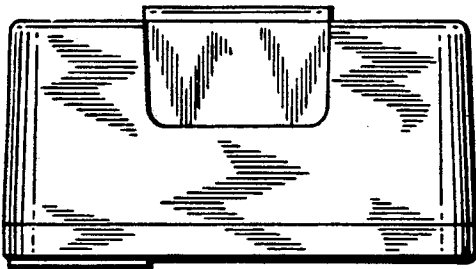

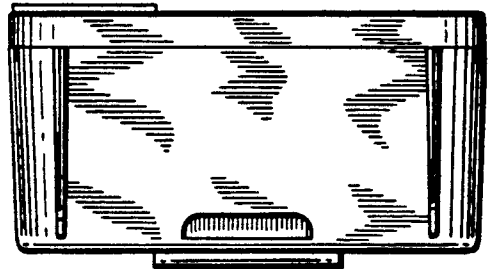

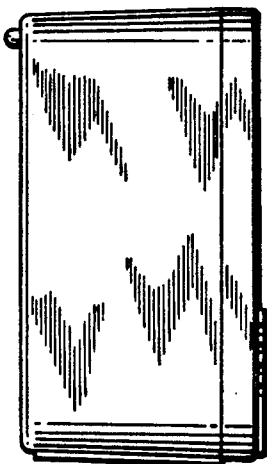
