




To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Seymour Levy, a citizen of the United States, residing in Tarrytown, in the county of Westchester, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Display Shelf, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a display shelf, showing my new design;
