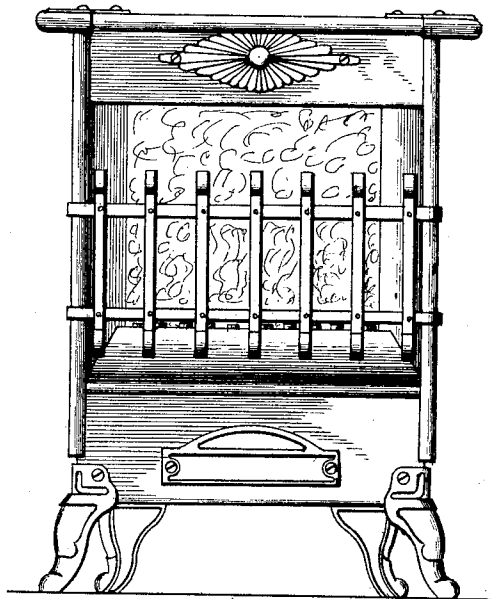

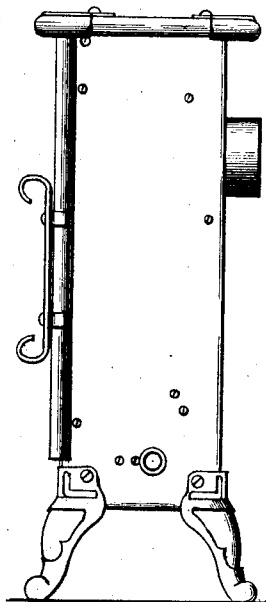
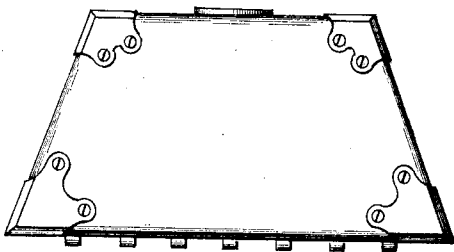

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JACOB E. DAVIS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Iron-ton, in the county of Lawrence and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Gas Heating-Stoves, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a gas heating stove showing my new design; Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the same; and Fig. 3 is a side elevation of the same.
