DESCRIPTION

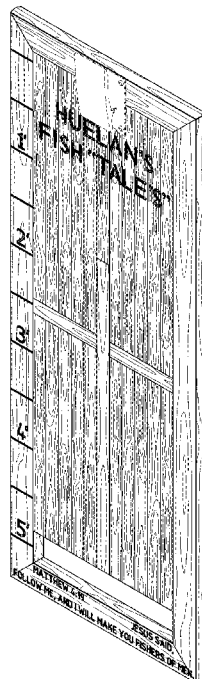
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fish cutting board;

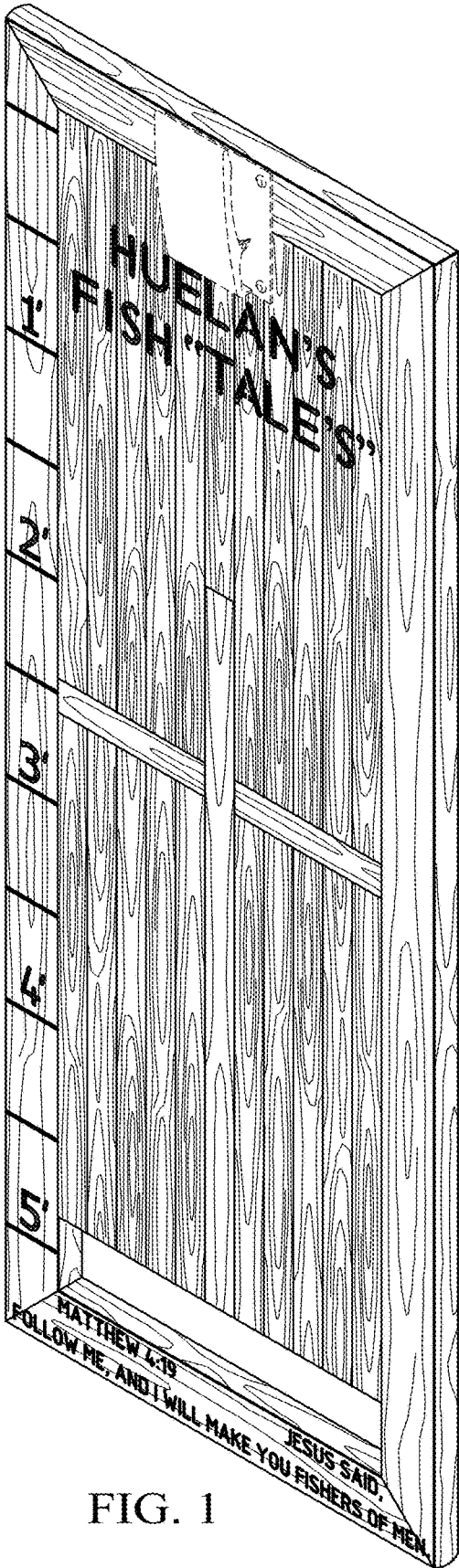

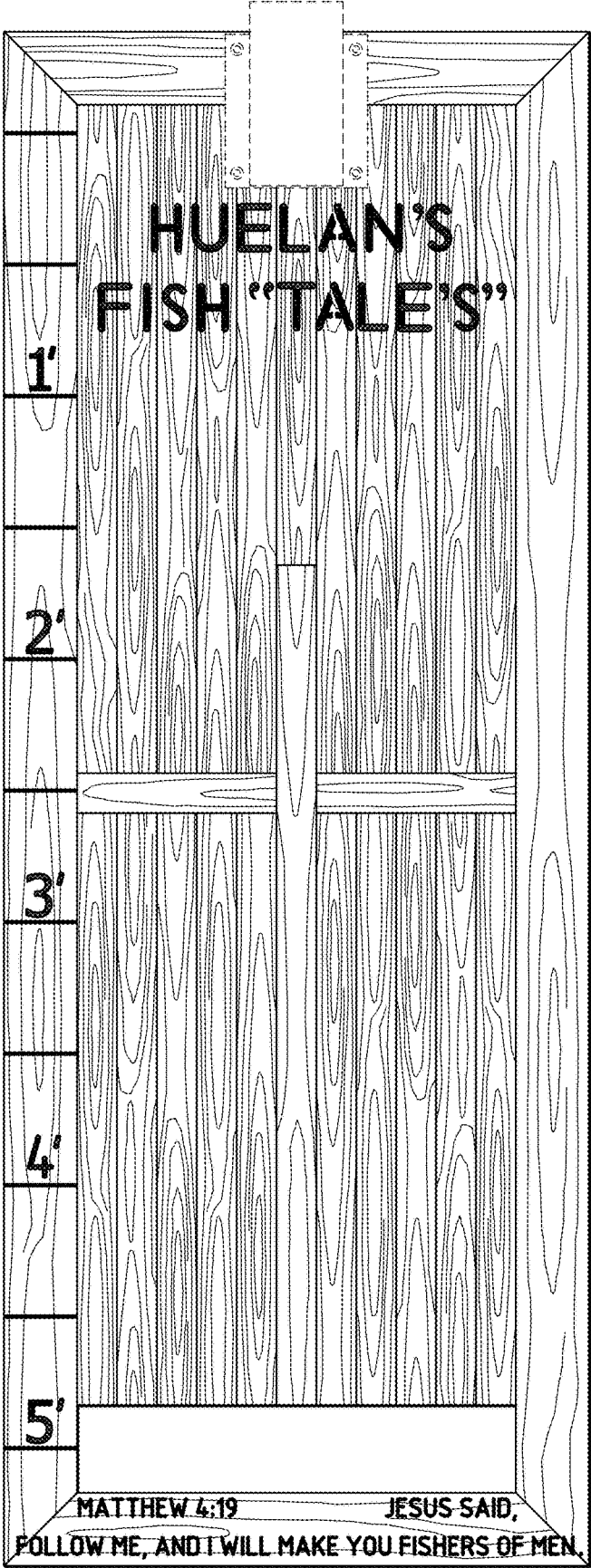

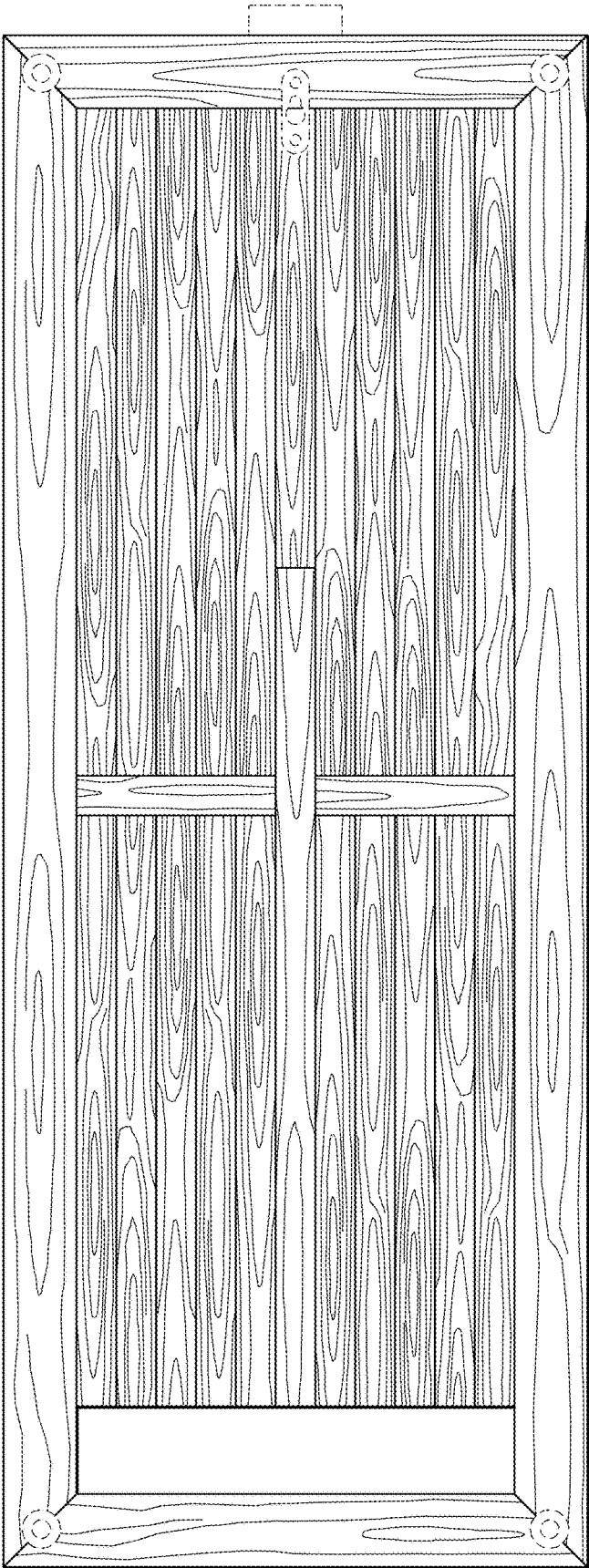

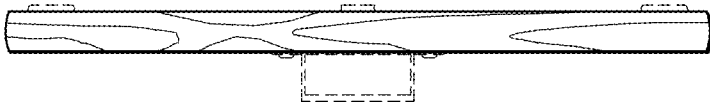

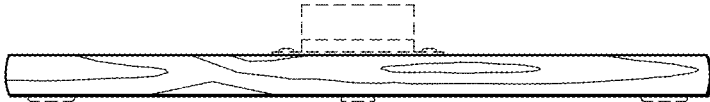
