

The ornamental design for a cracker, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cracker, embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a back elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top planar view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of an alternative embodiment of the cracker;

FIG. 10 is a top planar view thereof;
FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view thereof;


























