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

(54) Title: MOBILE GROUP DATA DISTRIBUTION



(57) Abstract: A mobile collaborative community system (300) provides distribution of shared data (e.g., media, preference, calendar, contacts, tasks, etc.) for a group of individuals (e.g., families, business organization, team, project, etc.) to the mobile devices (360, 361, 362) of the group members. The system maintains a central repository or database of shared data for groups (330, 331, 332), as well as information defining the groups (320), user membership in the groups, and the mobile devices associated with the users. The system distributes the shared data fox a group to the mobile devices of the user who are members of the group. The users can make changes to shared group data on their mobile devices, which changes are returned to the central repository and re-distributed to update the shared data on the mobile devices of all group members.

Group 1 solves the problem of collaboratively processing the shared data. The problem is solved by storing the distributed shared data on the mobile devices, returning information from the mobile devices of changes made to the shared data on the mobile devices, updating the central copy of the shared data with the changes and distributing information of the changes to the shared data to the mobile devices of the users belonging to the particular group.

2. claims: 3, 8, 11-15

Group 2 solves the problem of filtering the distribution of the shared data to save the resources of the network and the mobile devices. The problem is solved in that the group membership information further defines applications available on the individual mobile devices and the distribution of the shared data is to only those of the mobile devices of the users of the particular group that have an application for the shared data available.
