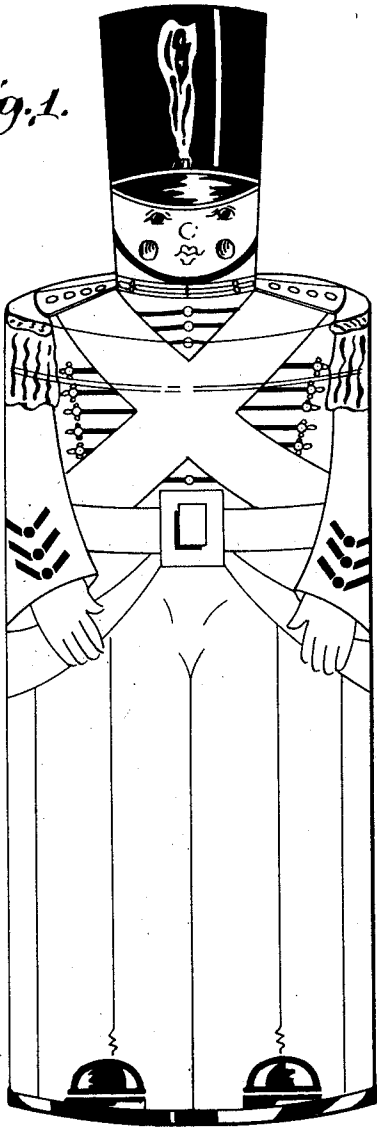

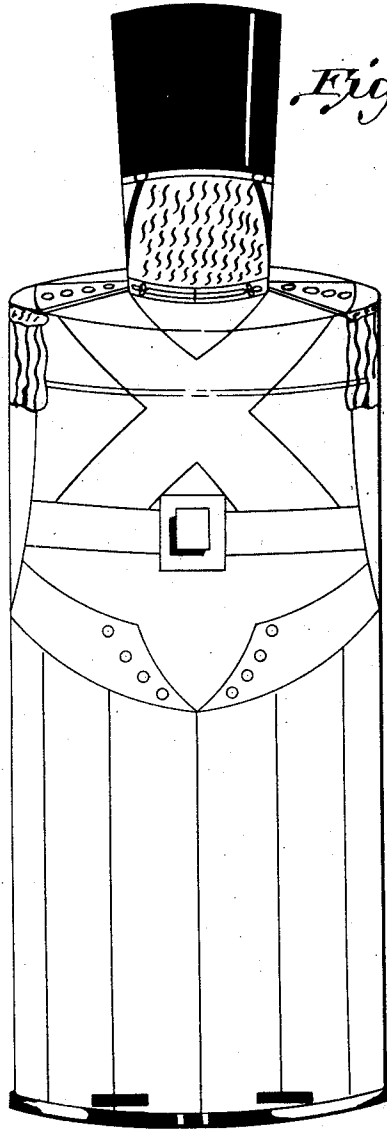
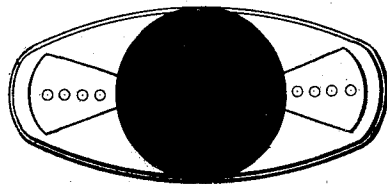

Be it known that I, William A.
