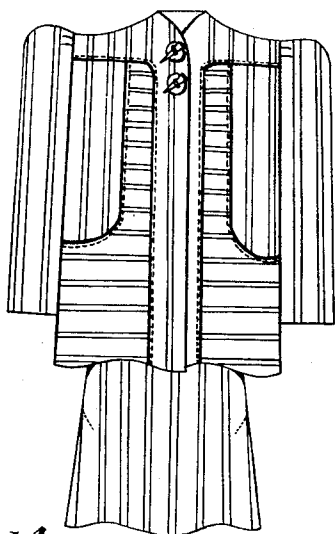

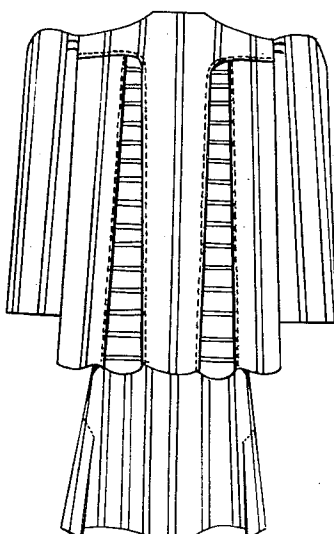

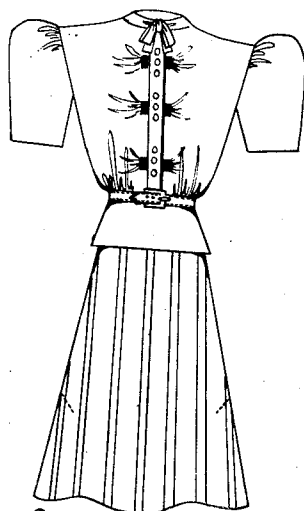

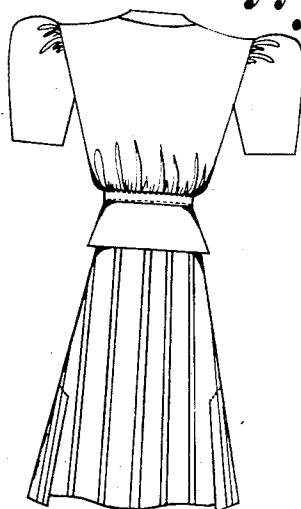

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Samuel Kuznetz, a citizen of the United States and a resident of the city of New York, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dress Ensemble, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front view of a dress ensemble showing my design.

Fig. 2 is a rear view thereof.

Fig. 3 is a front view of the dress section of the ensemble shown in Fig. 1.
