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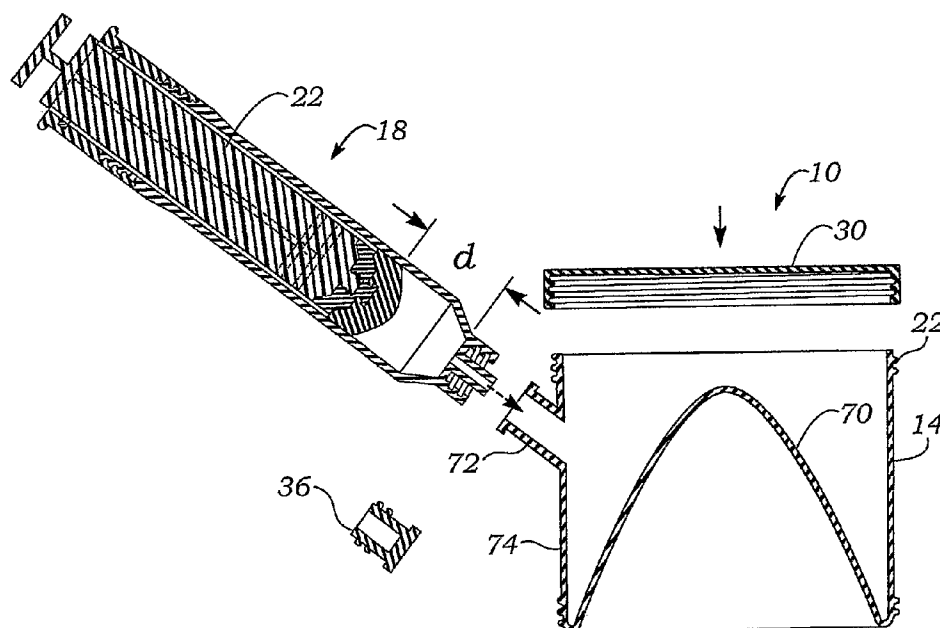
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(54) Title: BIOLOGICAL SPECIMEN COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION, AND DISPENSING SYSTEM



(57) Abstract: A body fluid collecting, transporting, and dispensing system includes a body fluid collecting receptacle and a handle for supporting the receptacle in a fluid collection position. The handle includes a fluid sample chamber in fluid communication with the receptacle to receive a sample of the body fluid and the handle is further removable from the receptacle for transport and dispensing of the body fluid sample.
