

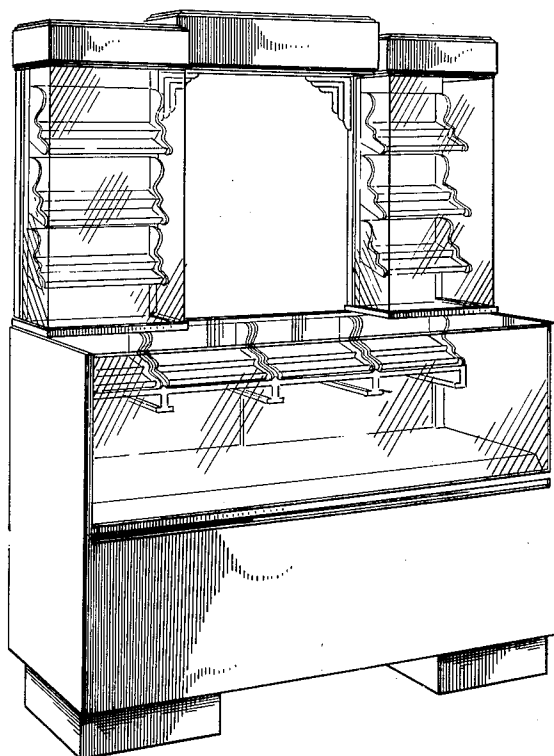

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Henry P. Vaughn, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city of Grand Rapids, in the county of Kent and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Display Case, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view of a display case, showing my new design.

The end of the case not shown is similar to the end which is shown. The back of the case is unornamented.
