

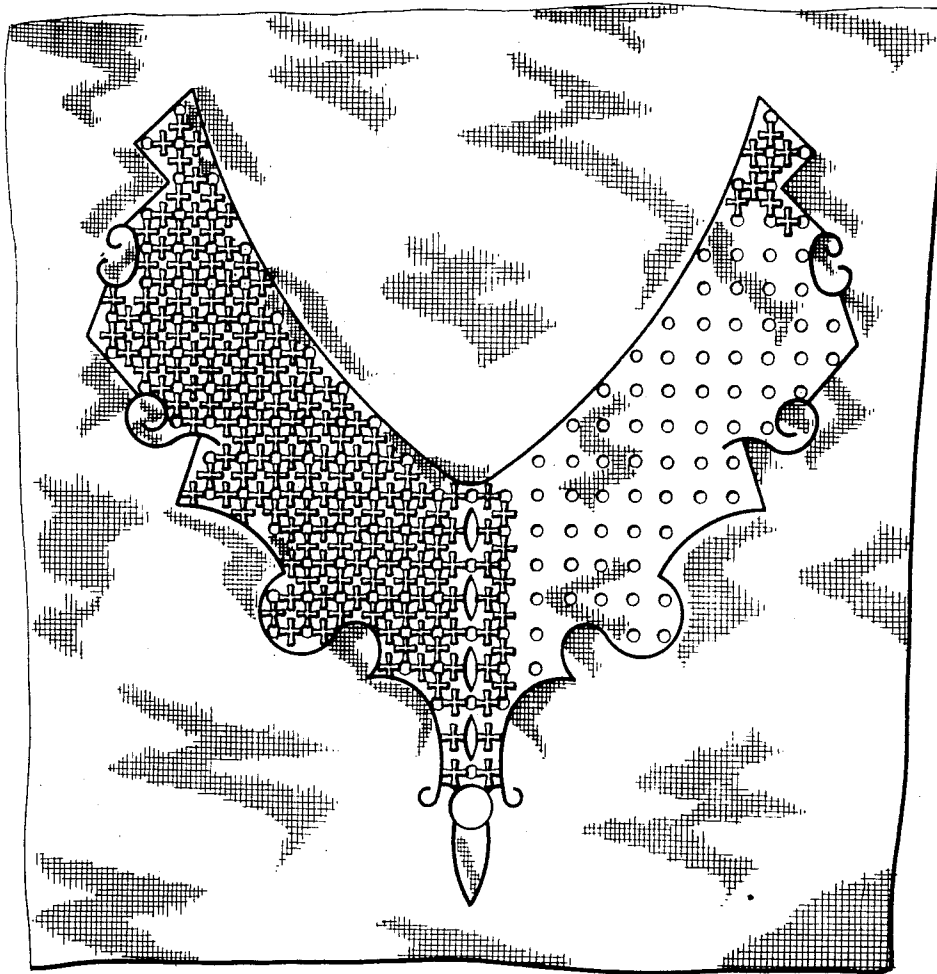

**DESIGN FOR NAILHEAD EMBROIDERED
PERFORATED TEXTILE FABRIC**

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ABRAHAM FRIEDENSOHN, a citizen of the United States, residing at #589 8th Avenue, New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Nailhead Embroidered Perforated Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric showing my new design.

The characteristic feature of my new design resides in the effect caused by the clamping of the nailheads in the perforations of the textile fabric.

The nailhead designs on the right hand side of the drawing are identical to the designs on the left hand side.

I claim:

The ornamental design for nailhead embroidered perforated textile fabric, as shown and described.
