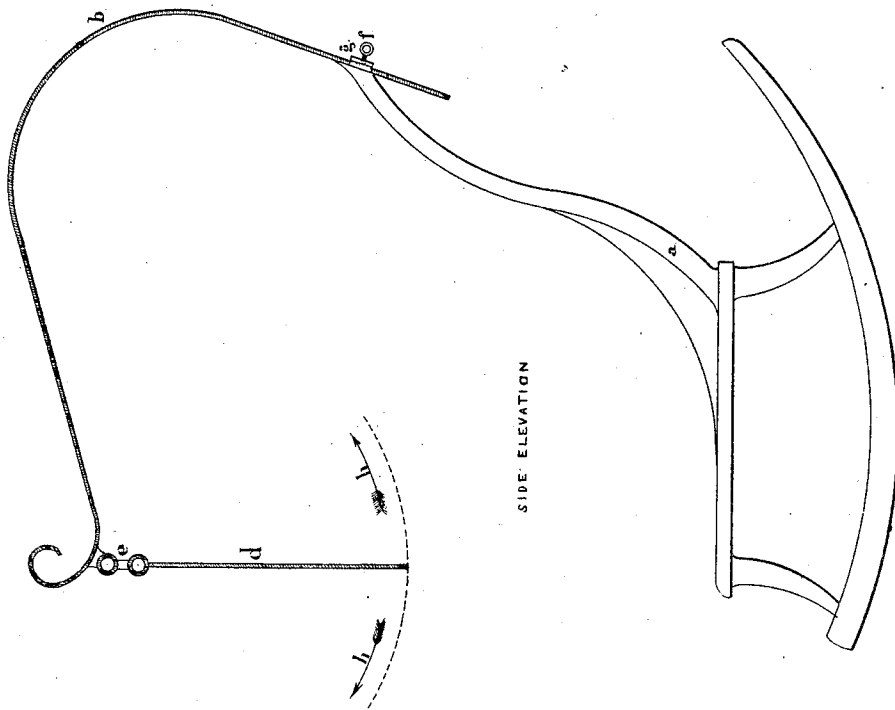

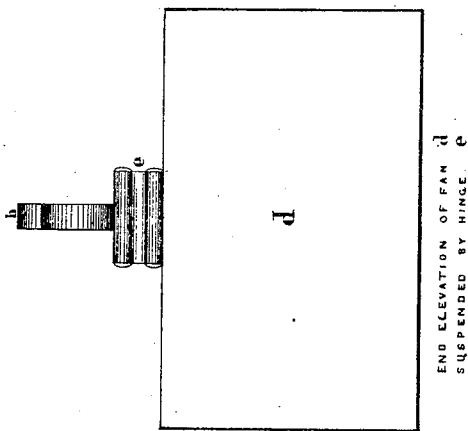

IMPROVED FAN ROCKING-CHAIR.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE R. G. JONES, in the county of Shelby and State of Tennessee, have invented a new and useful Device to be attached to any kind of Rocking-Chair or Cradle; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description of the construction and operation of the same, reference being had to the annexed drawings making a part of this specification, in which—

a is a rocking-chair.

b is an adjustable bow, which may be raised or lowered to suit the chair by means of pin or set-screw *f* and sliding piece *g*.

e is a hinge, to connect the fan *d* to adjustable bow *b*.

The nature of my invention consists in providing any rocking-chair or cradle with a vibrating fan, by means of an adjustable bow.

To enable others skilled in the art to make and use my invention, I will proceed to describe its construction and operation.

First, I attach by screws to the back of rocking-chair or side of cradle a square staple, *g*, made with hole through it for pin, or with a set-screw, *f*, like the drawing.

The bow *b*, made of wood, brass, steel, or other material suitable, I insert in the square slot or staple *g*. Then I attach the vibrating fan *d* by means of hinge *e* to the adjustable bow *b*, the fan to be made of wood, paper, cloth, or other light material, with frame-work, of wood or wire, or other suitable stuff.

What I claim as my improvement in a device for giving motion to a fan, is—

In the construction of the adjustable bow *b*, with its staple and thumb-screw *g* and *f*, in combination with fan *d*, connecting hinge *e*, and chair *a*, as shown and described.
