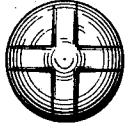

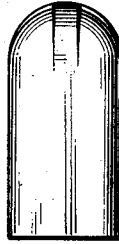

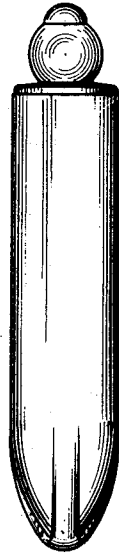
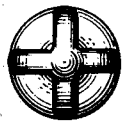

DESIGN FOR A PERFUME DISPENSER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ladislao J. Biro, a citizen of Hungary, residing at Buenos Aires, Argentina, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Perfume Dispensers, of which the following is a specification, reference being made to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing Fig. 1 is a side view, Fig. 2 a top view and Fig. 3 a bottom view of a perfume dispenser, with its protective cap in closed position, and Fig. 4 is a side view of the dispenser with said cap removed exposing the applicator portion of the dispenser, said figures showing my new design.
