

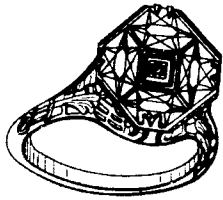

DESIGN FOR A FINGER RING.

Application filed February 9, 1926. Serial No. 16,461. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ISIDOR STERN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Finger Rings, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
