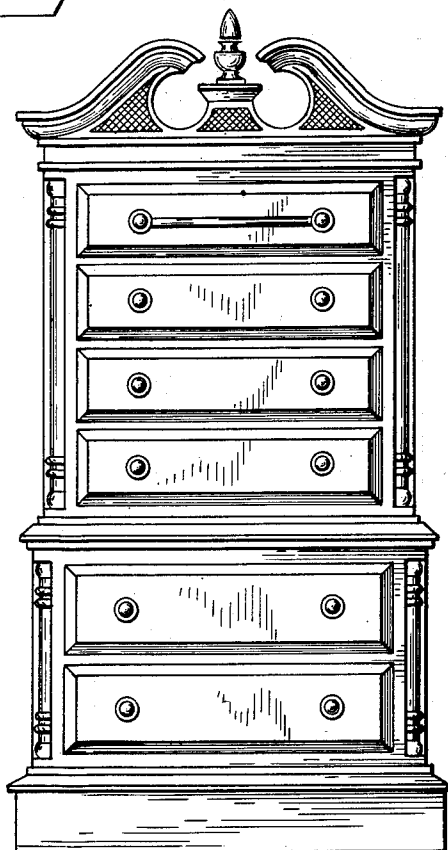

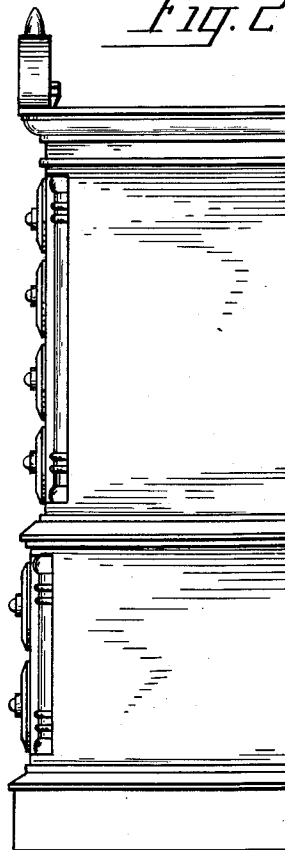
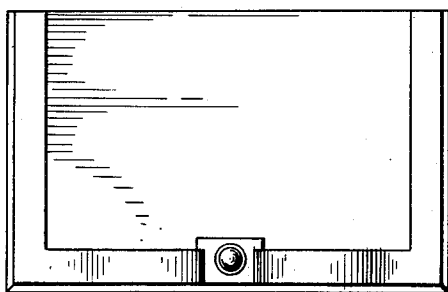

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Arthur F. Klingberg, a citizen of the United States and resident of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Coin Bank, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a coin bank, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.

Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof.
