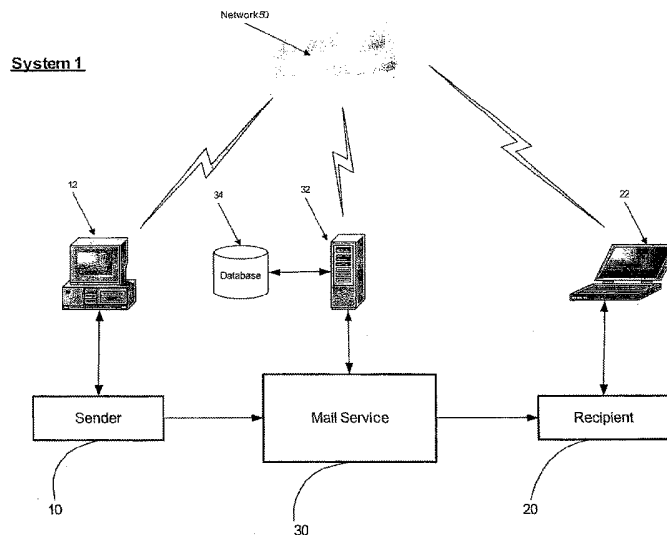

(54) Title: PERSONAL INTELLIGENT SHIPMENT SYSTEM AND METHOD



(57) Abstract: Described is a personalized shipment system. The user is registered by providing user data which is associated with a unique user identifier ("UUI"). Label data is generated for each label which includes a unique label identifier ("ULI") in a machine language ("ML"). The ULI is associated with the UUI in a database. An item to be shipped with a label and recipient data which includes a destination data ("DD") of the item is received. When the DD is not in the ML, the DD is translated into ML DD ("MLDD"). The ULI and the MLDD are obtained using a machine capable of reading the ML during the item's shipment. The tracking data is recorded the database based on the ULI and the ML data. The tracking data regarding shipment progress of the item is provided in response to a request referencing the UUI and/or the DD.
