(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a portion of a flash suppressor for a firearm, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a portion of a flash suppressor for a firearm in accordance with the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the portion of a flash suppressor for a firearm of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the portion of a flash suppressor for a firearm of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right elevation view of the portion of a flash suppressor for a firearm of FIG. 1;


FIG. 5 is a left elevation view of the portion of a flash suppressor for a firearm of FIG. 1;














