[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fishing lure, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the fishing lure, showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top elevation of the fishing lure;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom elevation thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a front elevation thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a rear elevation of the fishing lure illustrated in FIGS. 1-6.
