FIG. 5 is a first end view thereof;

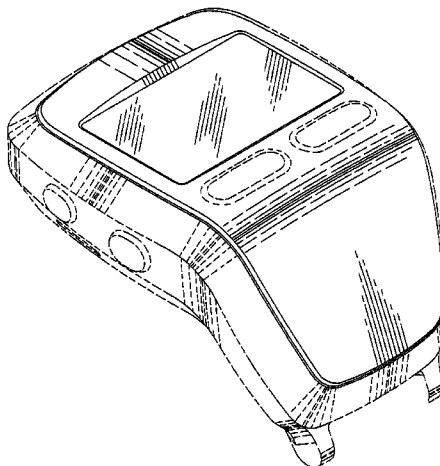
FIG. 6 is a second end view opposite the first end thereof;

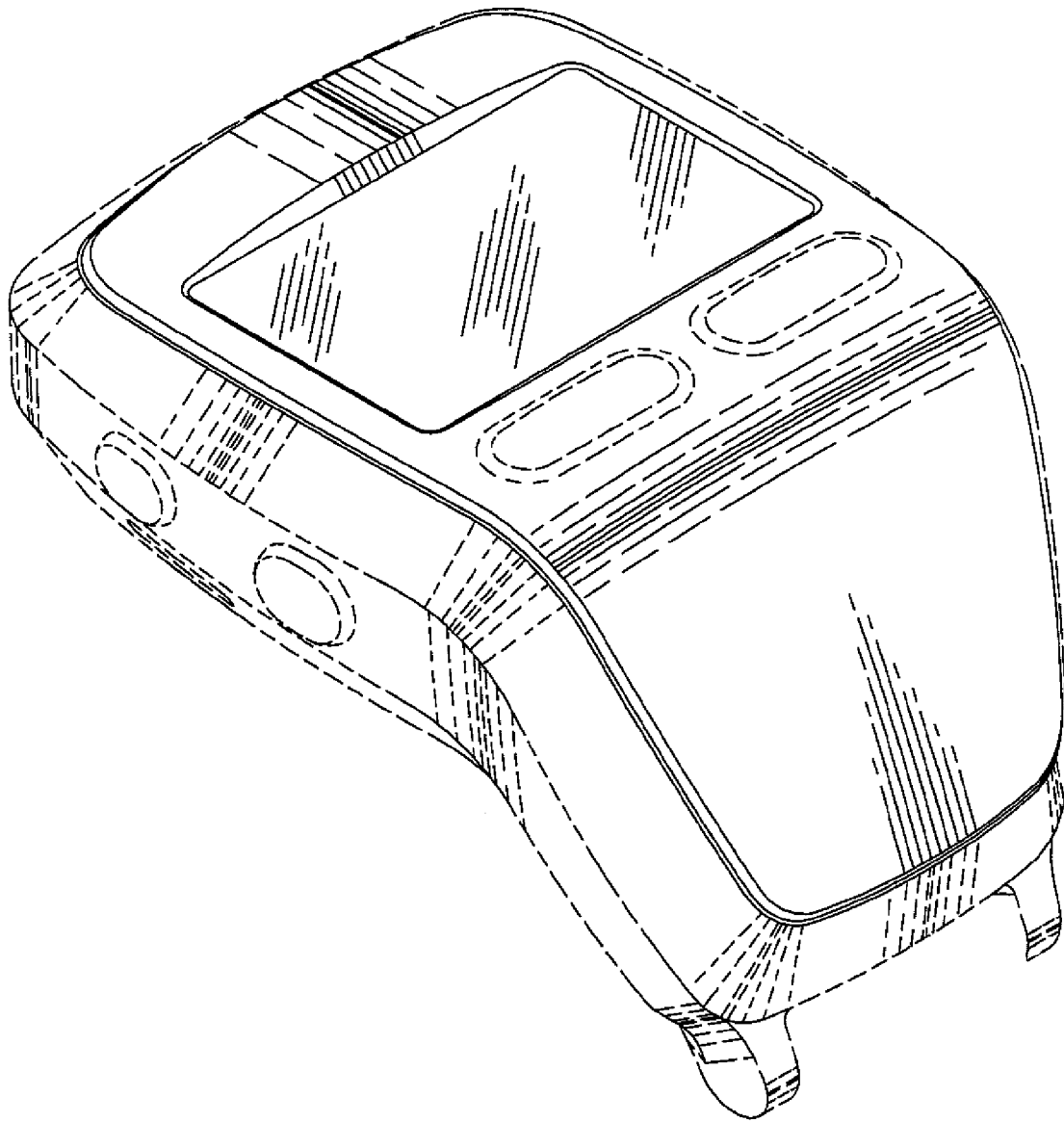

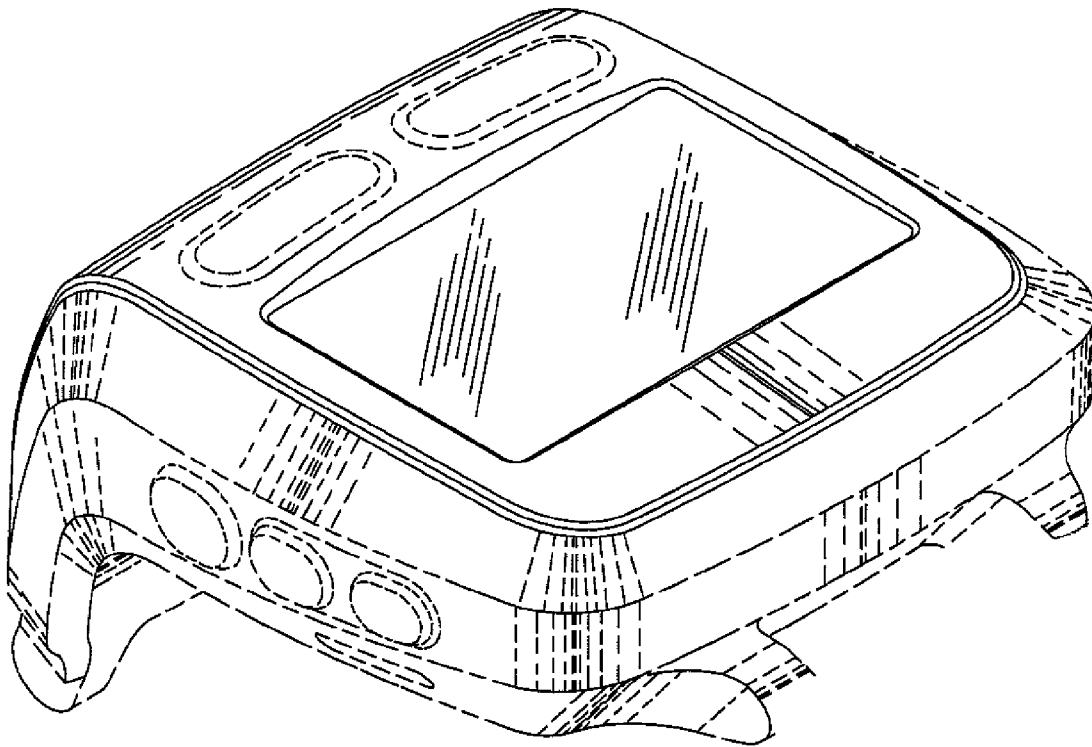

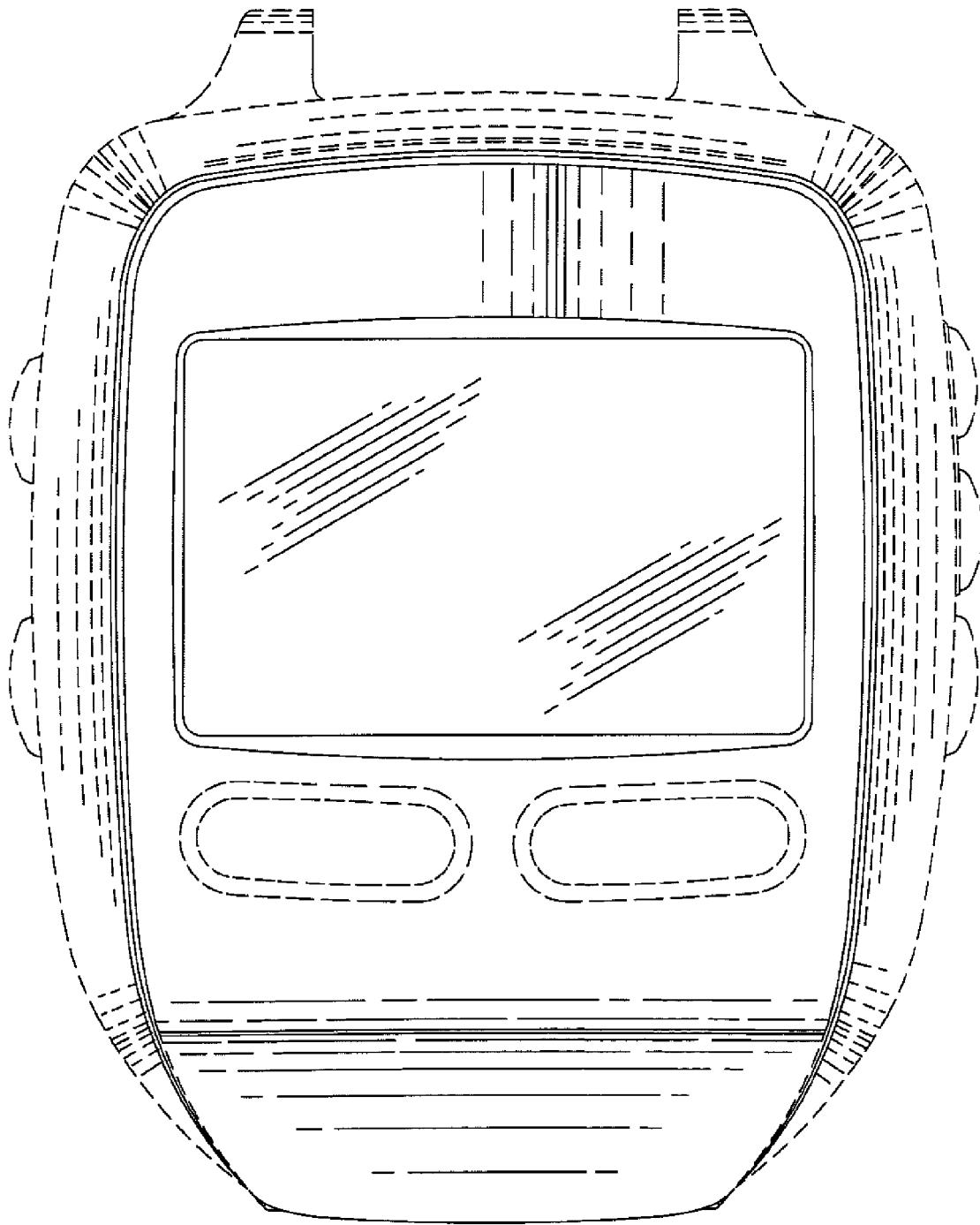

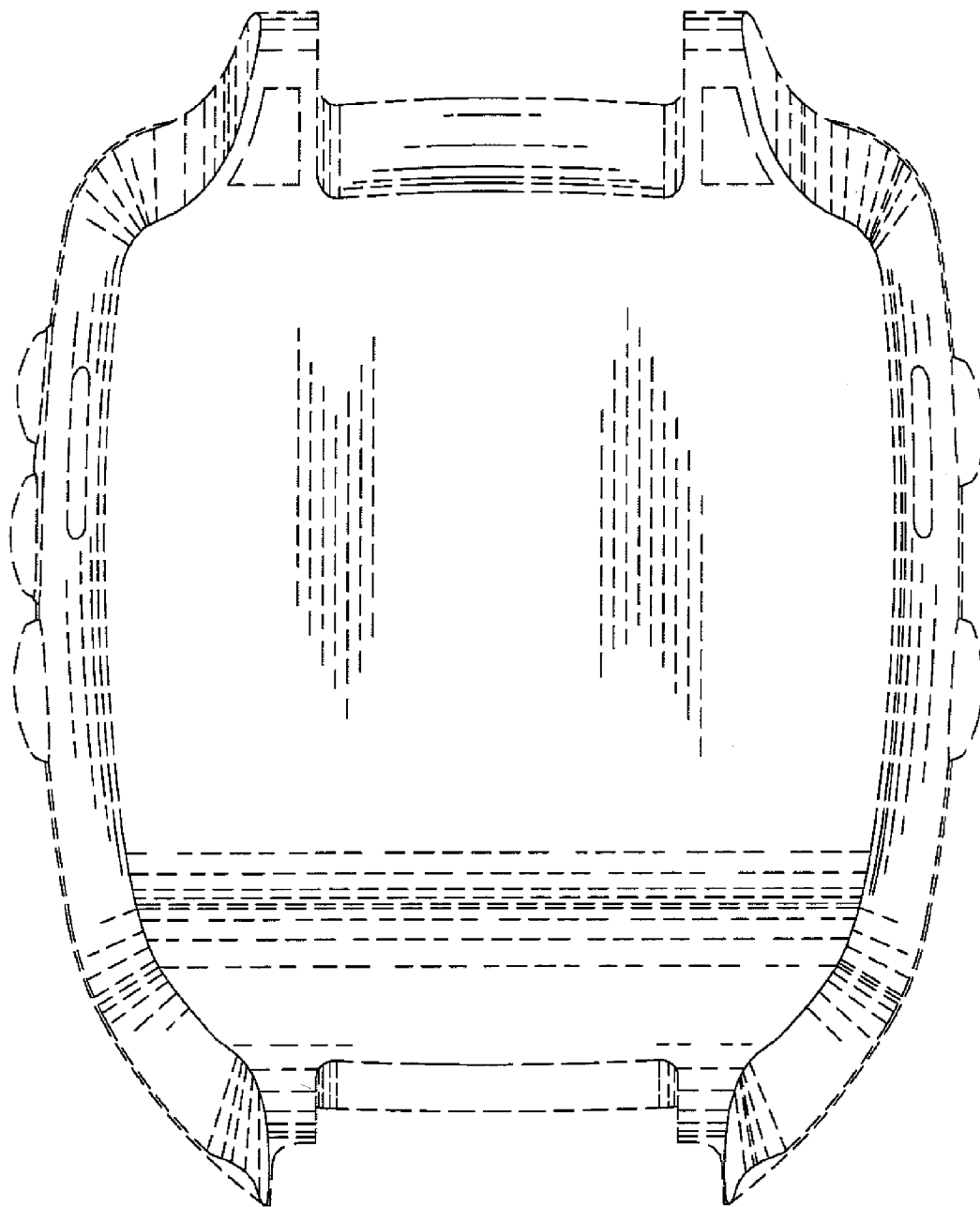

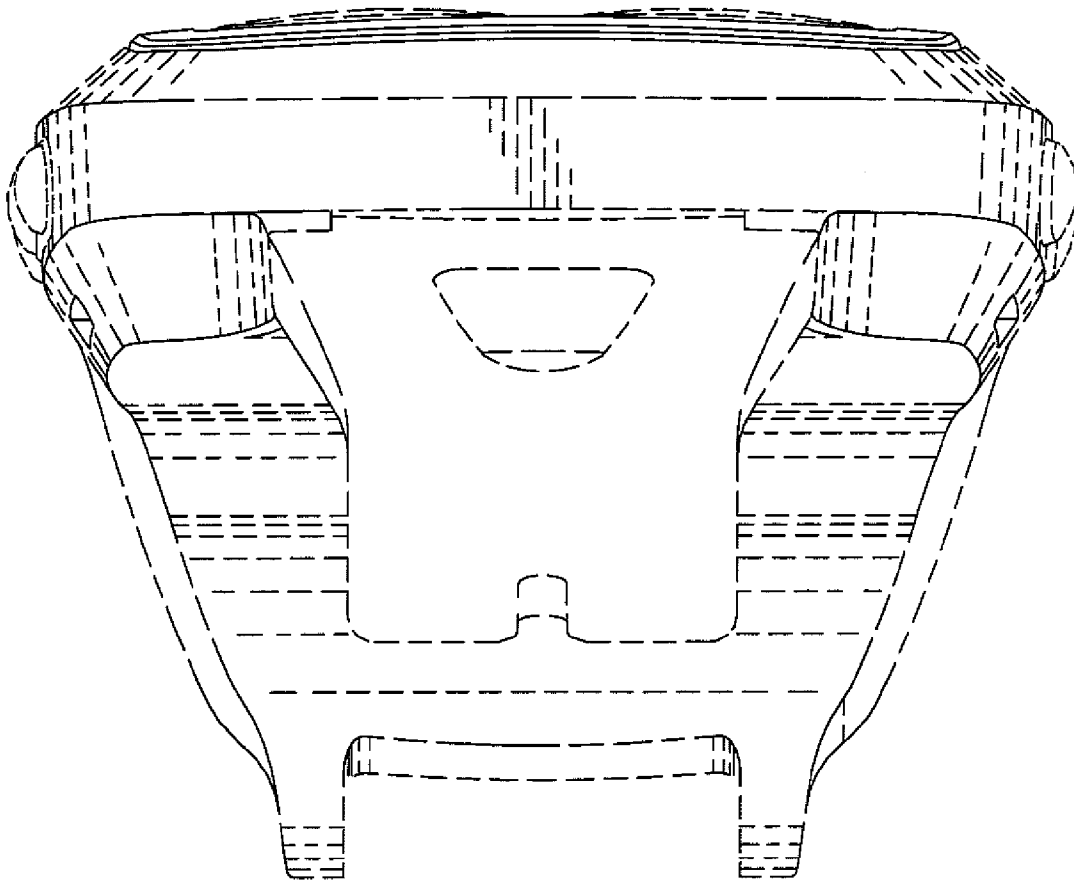

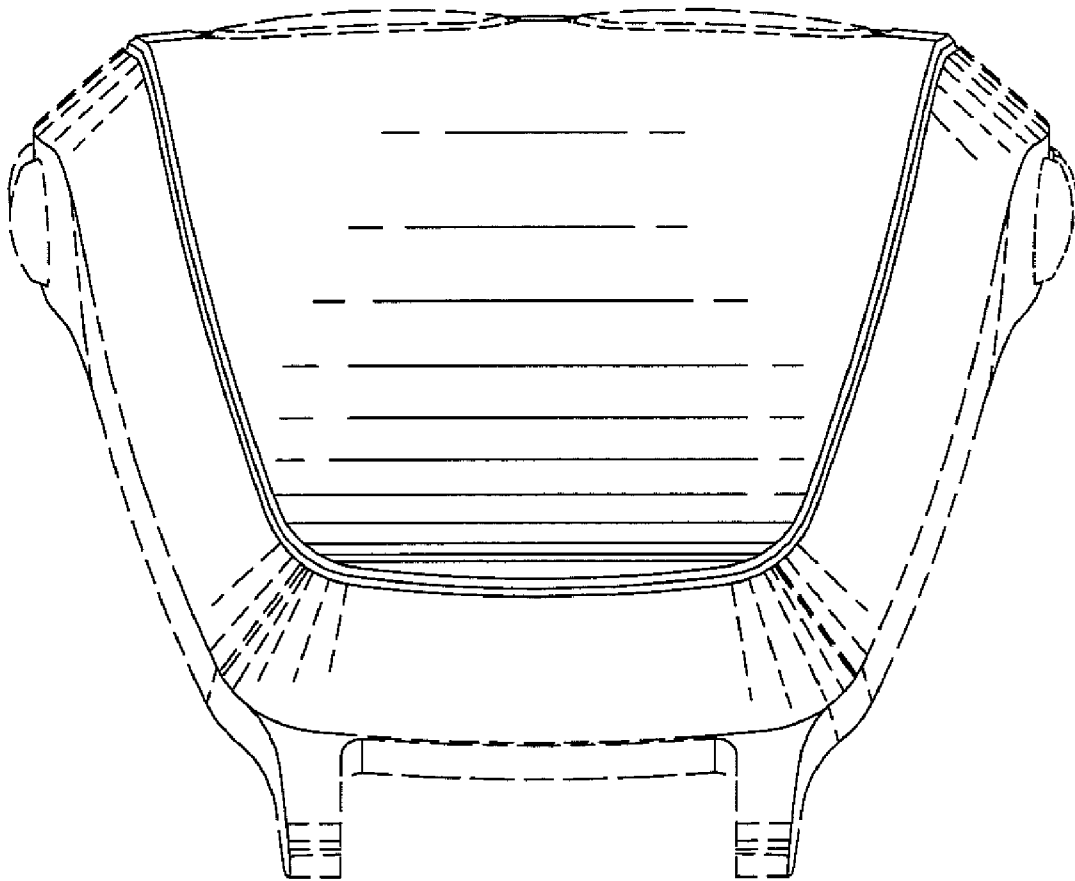
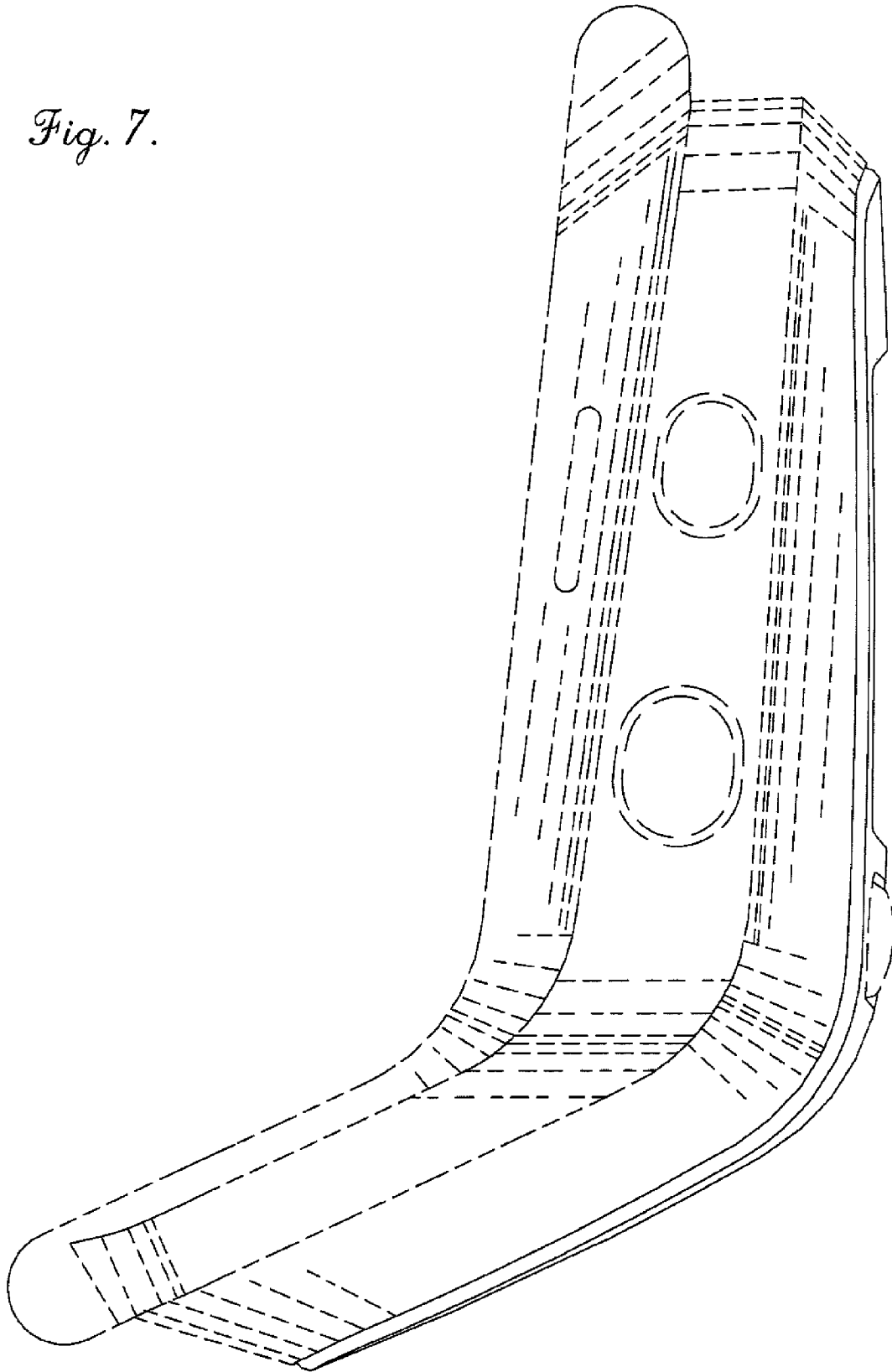

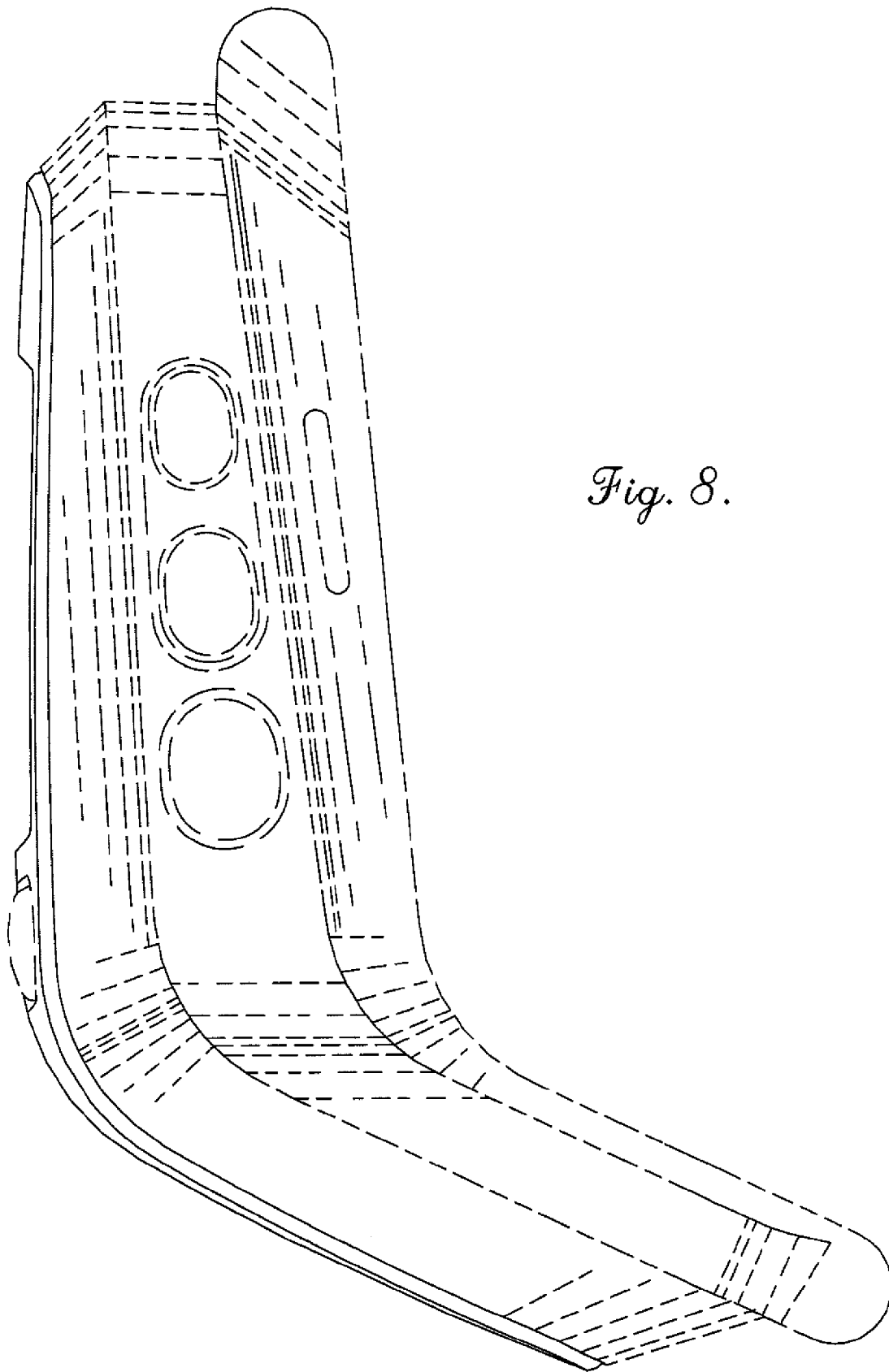
