The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent & making part of the same

To all whom it may concern:—

Be it known that I, James Conner, of the city and county of New York, in the State of New York, Type Founder, have invented, or produced a new style, set, or cut of Printing Types for Letter press printing of a new and original design, which I describe as follows, viz: Conners American Scripts.

They are of a kind known to the trade as Scripts, (see annexed printed impression of characters) and of the size usually known as and called Double Small Pica No. 3, but this Script differs from all other Script Types in style, proportion, size, shape peculiarity of points, having final hair lines attached, and flourishes, which form a part, and go to constitute this set of Double Small Pica Script.

I call this new Type "Conners American Script", and I claim the Design of the Types as described and shown in the "characters" of the accompanying Types, and Printed sheet.
