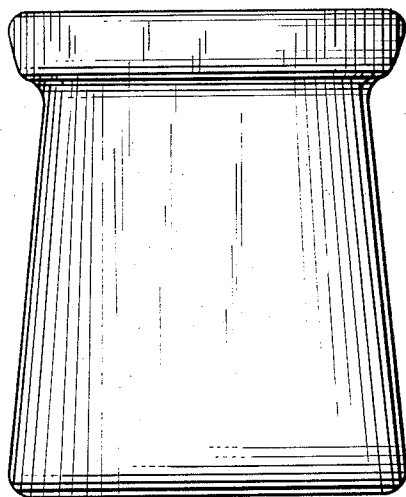

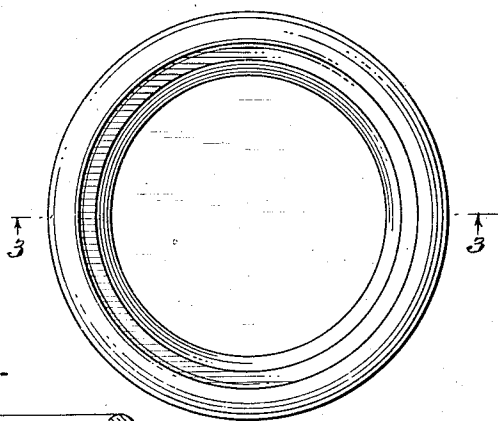
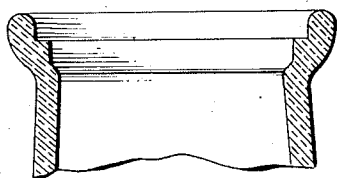

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles Forgue, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof, in which

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a bottle embodying the new design;

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the same; and
Figure 3 is a sectional view on the line 3—3 of Figure 2, looking in the direction of the arrows.
