

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fish lure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of the right side of a fish lure incorporating my new design, the left side view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view.












