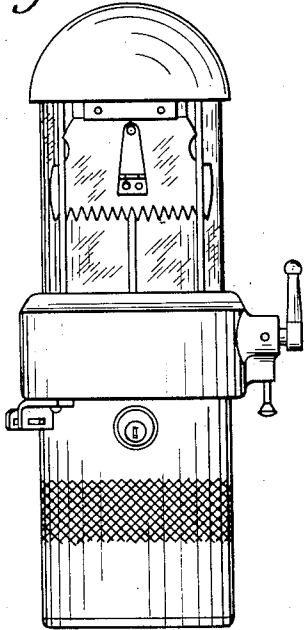

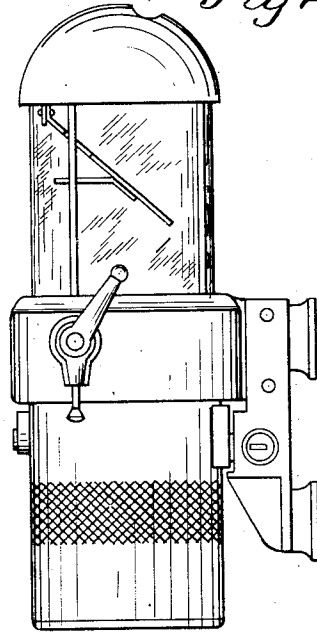

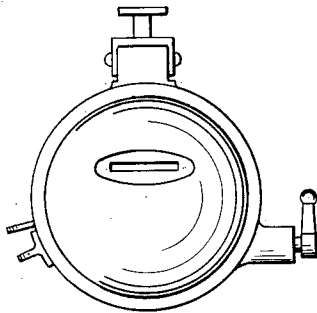

## DESIGN FOR A FARE BOX

Frederick D. Pitt, Kansas City, Mo.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Frederick D. Pitt, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Kansas City, in the county of Jackson and State of Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fare Boxes, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part

thereof, in which, Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a fare box, showing my new design. Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the same. Fig. 3 is a plan view of the same.
