

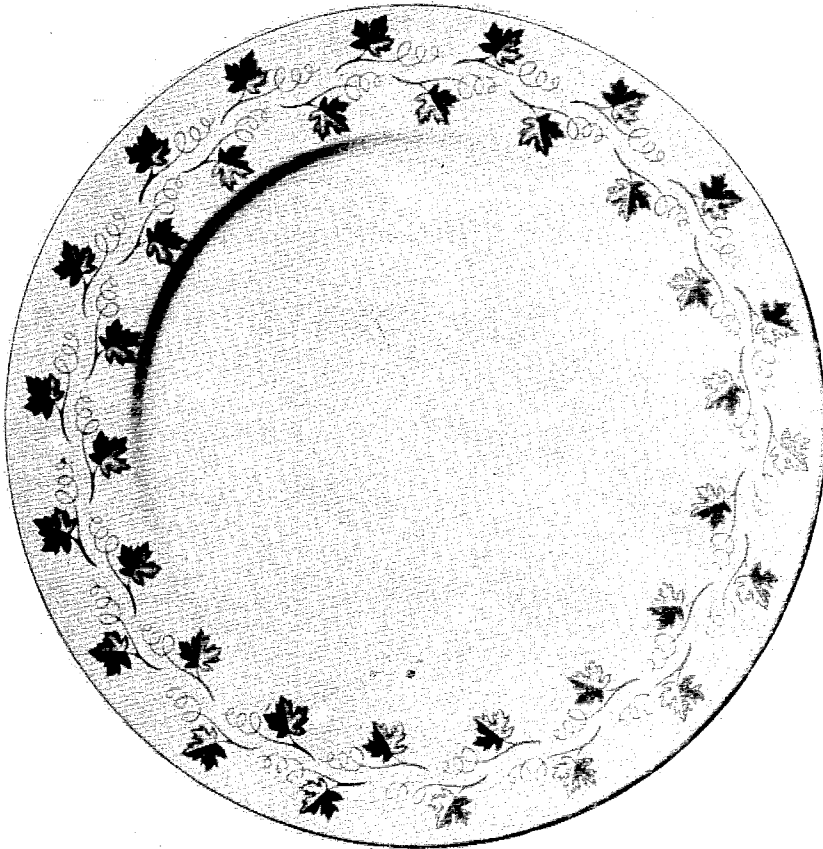

### *To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Charles H. McKaig, a citizen of the United States, residing at Camillus, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dinner Plate or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part hereof.

The drawing is a plan view of a plate of conventional configuration showing my new design. The dominant feature of the design resides in the ornamentation shown on the plate.
