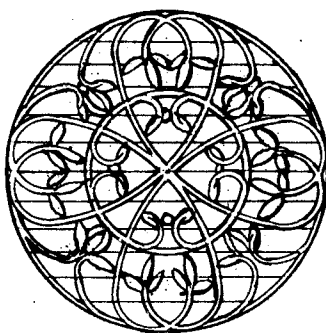

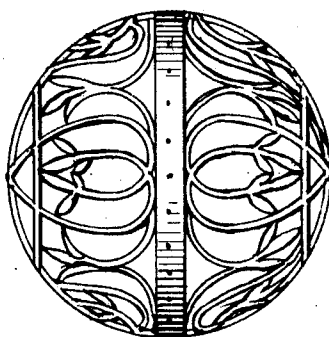
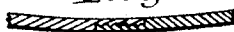

DESIGN FOR A RESILIENT TOY BALL.

Application filed April 25, 1927. Serial No. 21,715. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that RUDOLF D. KAFKA, a citizen of the United States, residing at 369 E. 124th St., Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Resilient Toy Balls, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing—

Fig. 1 is a plan of the ball, and Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof. Fig. 3 is a transverse section of overlapping edges of the sections of which the ball is composed.

The ornamental design for a resilient toy ball substantially as shown.
