








To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Carlo Gilardi, citizen of the Italian Republic, residing at Milan, Italy, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Motor Bicycle, of which the following is a specification, reference being made to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a motor bicycle showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof taken from the opposite side; and

Figs. 3, 4 and 5 are cross-sectional views taken along the lines 3—3, 4—4 and 5—5 respectively.

The dominant features of my design reside in that portion shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a motor bicycle, as shown and described.
