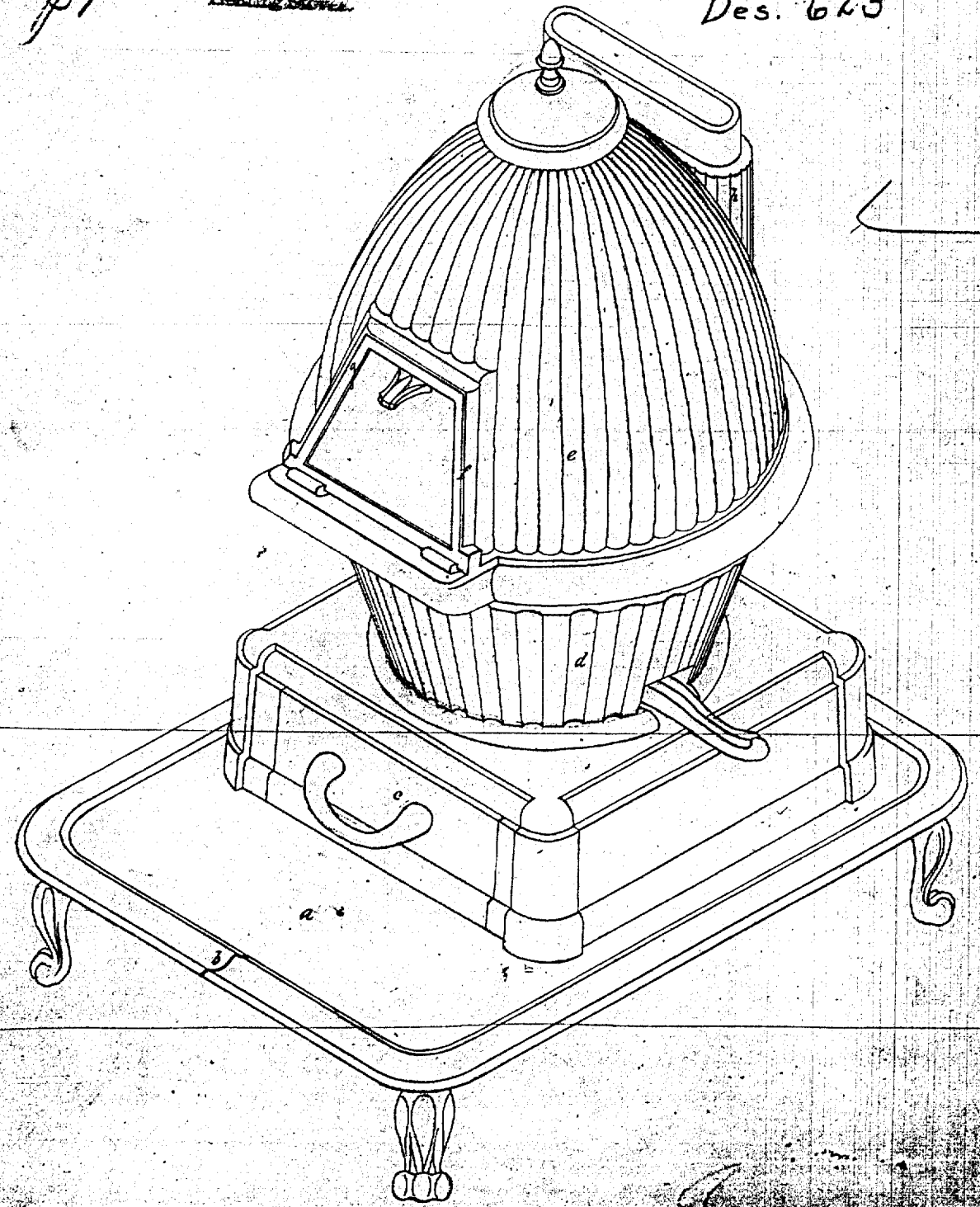

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent, and making part of the same

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Wm. Resor, of Cincinnati in the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio, have produced a new Ornamental Design for a "Cannon Stove," and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the annexed drawings making part of this specification, and in which the stove is represented by a perspective view.

(a) is the fender, skirted by an ogee moulding, whose contour is represented by the dark lines (b). The ash chamber (c) is of a quadrangular form and is decorated with beads, recessed surfaces, & rounded edges, as represented. Upon the ash chamber stands the lower section (d) of the fire chamber being in the form & position of an inverted conic frustum. This section is ornamented by flutes in the manner shown, and is surrounded by a dome shaped smoke chamber (e) beaded longitudinally as represented. The margin of the doorway has a quarter round moulding (f). The fire door is skirted by a flat moulding (g). The nozzle (h) for the smoke pipe is beaded like the dome.

I claim the ornamental design or pattern for a stove, substantially as represented and described. — In testimony whereof, I have hereto set my hand before two subscribing witnesses.
