## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the clip in the open position;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the clip illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the clip illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view of the clip illustrated in FIG. 1;


FIG. 5 is a perspective view like FIG. 1 showing the clip of my invention in thE closed position adapted to hold a mini bulb:


FIG. 6 is a top view of the clip illustrated in FIG. 5;


FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the clip illustrated in FIG. 5; and,







