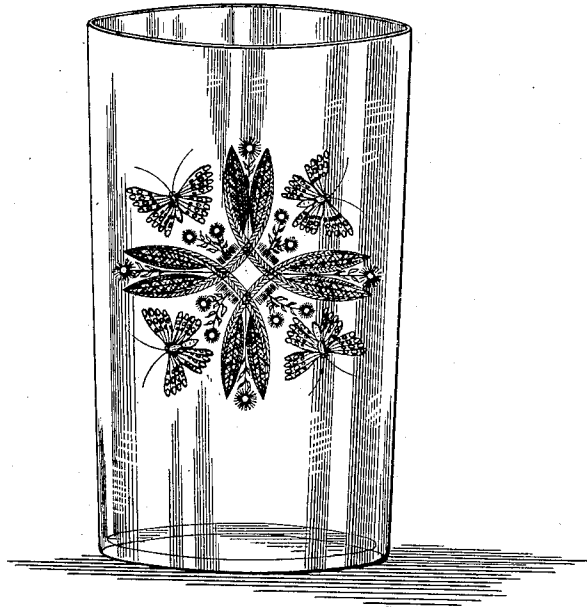

DESIGN FOR A GLASS VESSEL OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,910, dated May 10, 1904.
