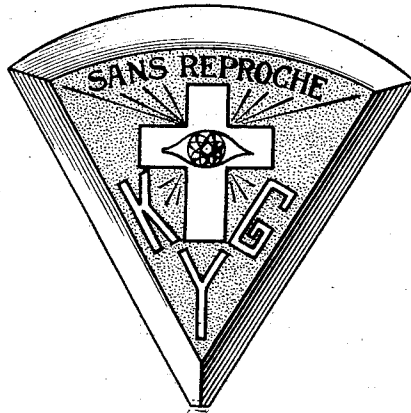

DESIGN FOR A BADGE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

Application filed July 1, 1924. Serial No. 10,022. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:
