

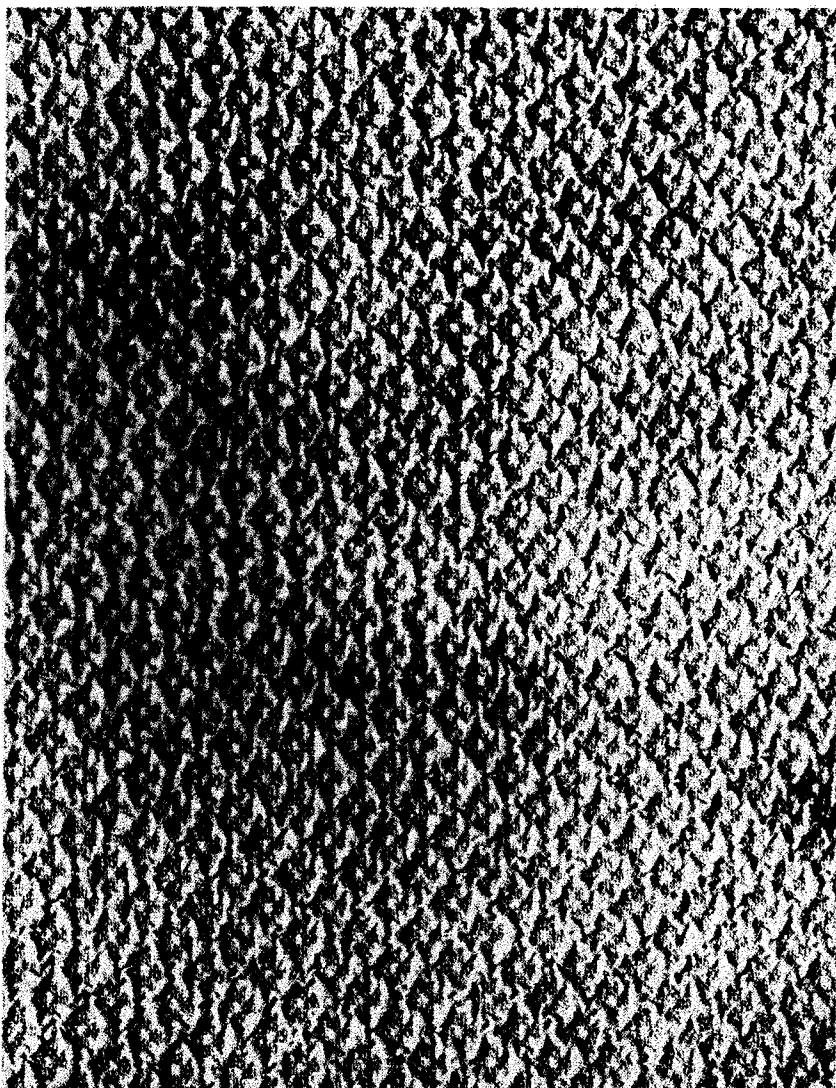

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis J. Brenner, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure on the drawing is a plan view of a textile fabric showing my new design.

The design is characterized by a series of crinkled rosette like elements arranged over the surface of the fabric as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric substantially as shown and described.
