FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

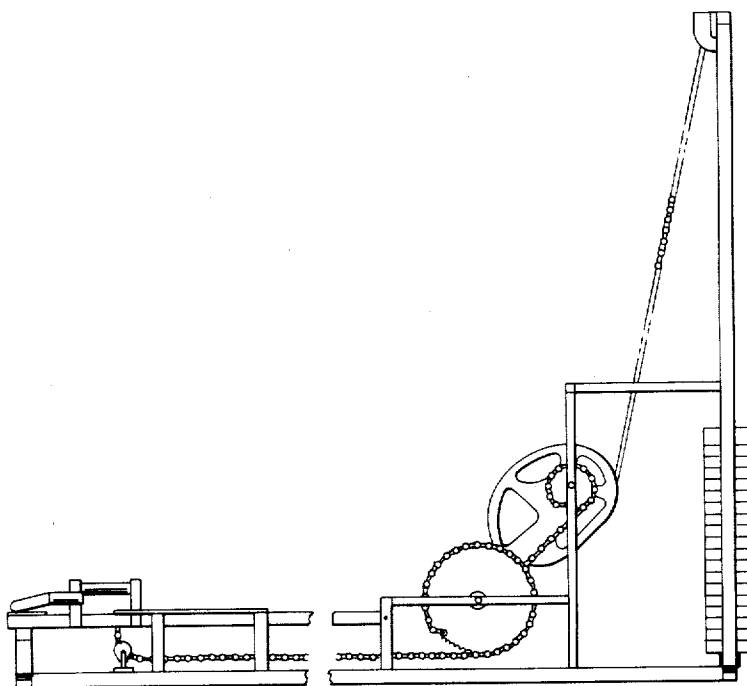
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

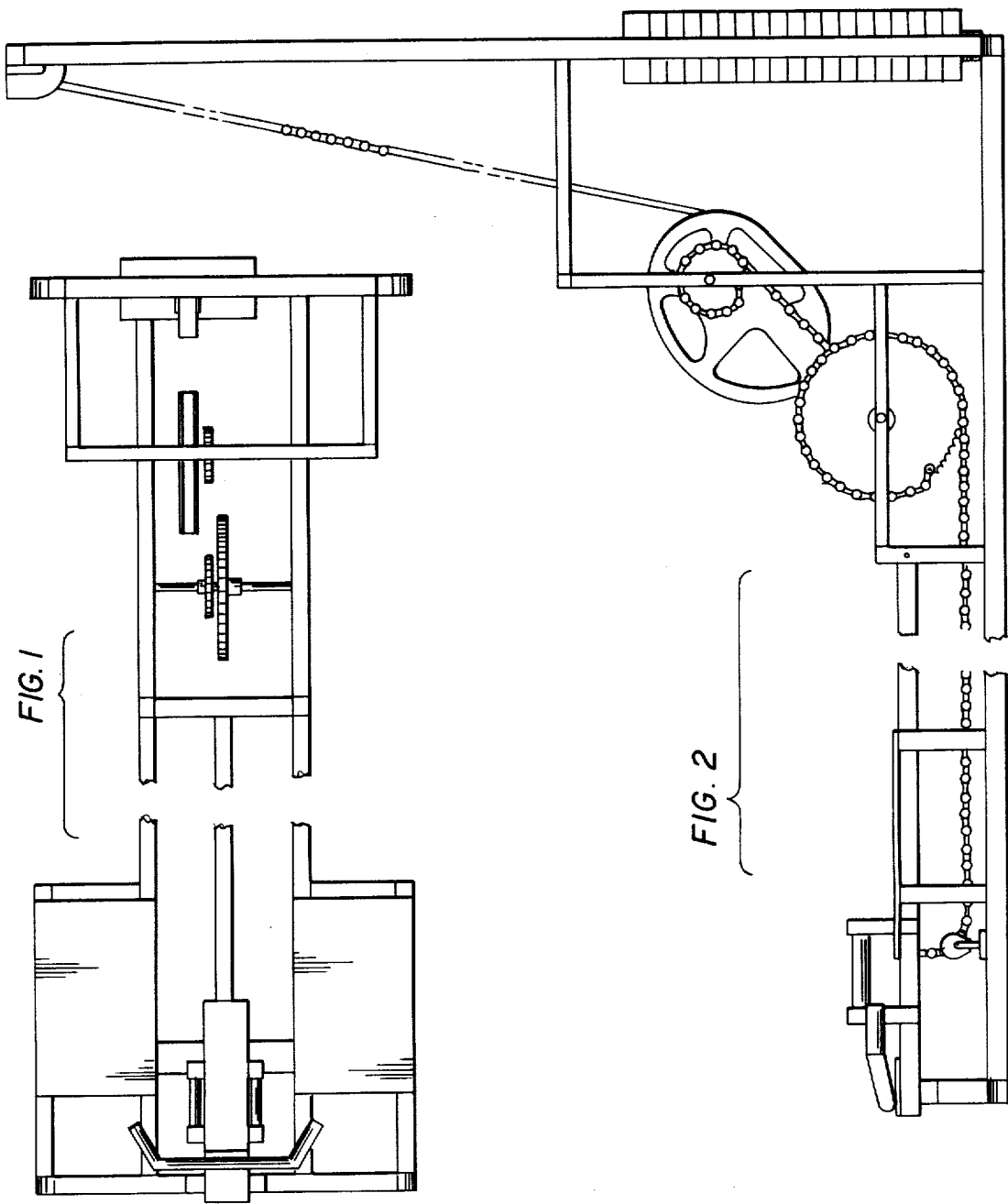
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;

The frame members have been partially shown in fragment in FIGS. 1 through 4 to indicate indeterminate length.





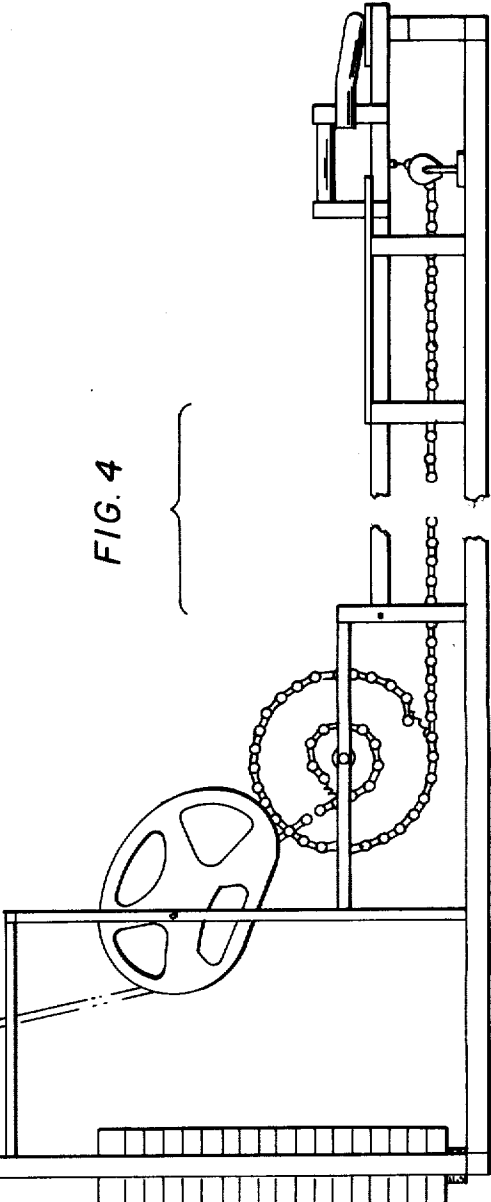
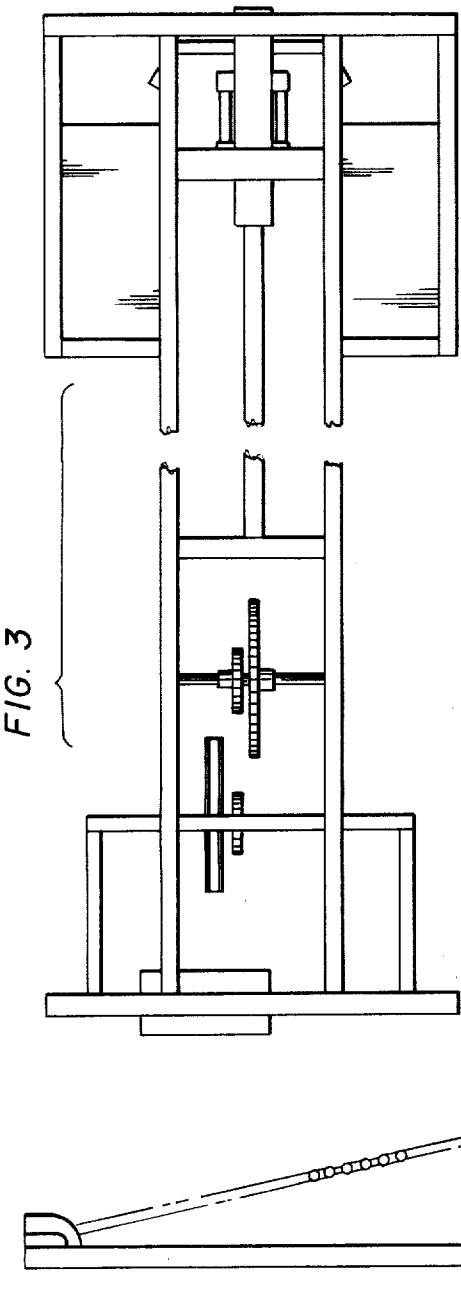

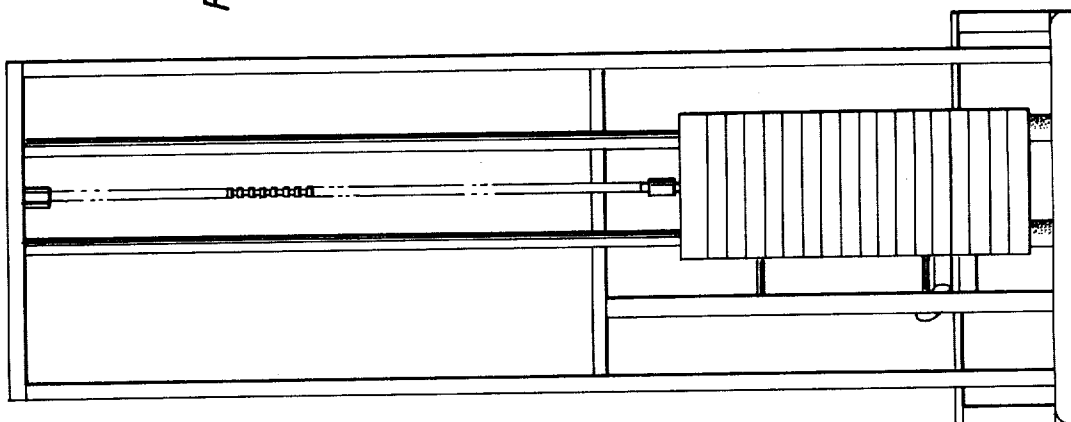
