

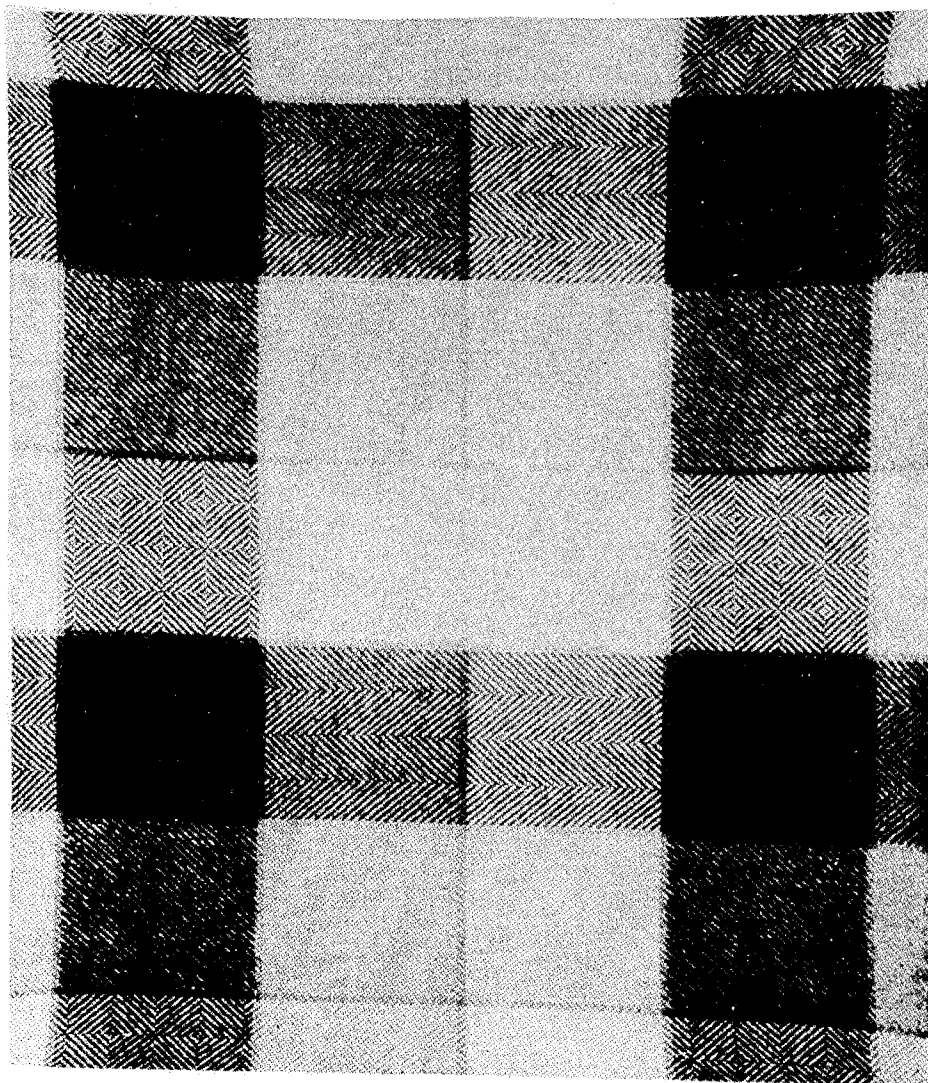

To whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William A. Landry, a citizen of the United States, residing at White Plains, in the county of Westchester and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had
