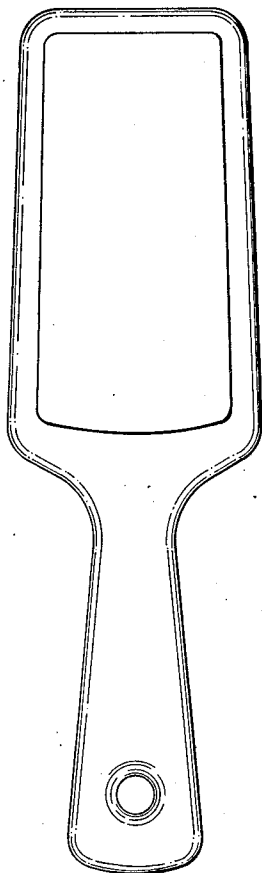

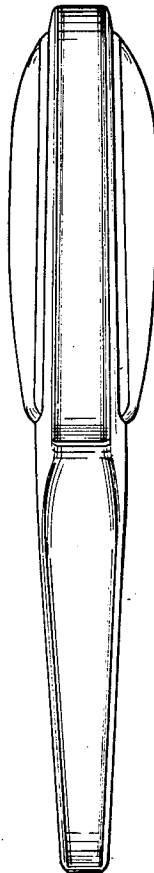

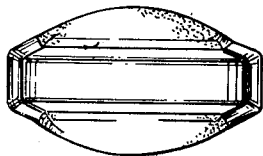

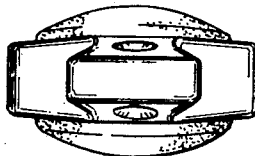


FIG. 1 is a front plan view of a double-sided brush showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view looking from either the right or left of FIG. 1;
