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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the rack-mount audio component with removable ears and honeycomb pattern, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the rack-mount audio component with removable ears and honeycomb pattern showing the new design, and with a front panel door in the open position. FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the rack-mount audio component with removable ears and honeycomb pattern of FIG. 1 with the front panel door in a closed position.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the rack-mount audio component with removable ears and honeycomb pattern of FIG. 1 with the front panel door in a closed position.

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the rack-mount audio component with removable ears and honeycomb pattern of FIG. 1 with the front panel door in a closed position.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the rack-mount audio component with removable ears and honeycomb pattern of FIG. 1 with the front panel door in a closed position.

FIG. 6 is a back elevational view of the rack-mount audio component with removable ears and honeycomb pattern of FIG. 1 with the front panel door in a closed position.

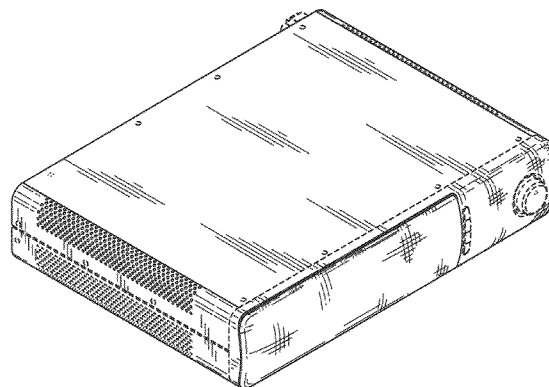
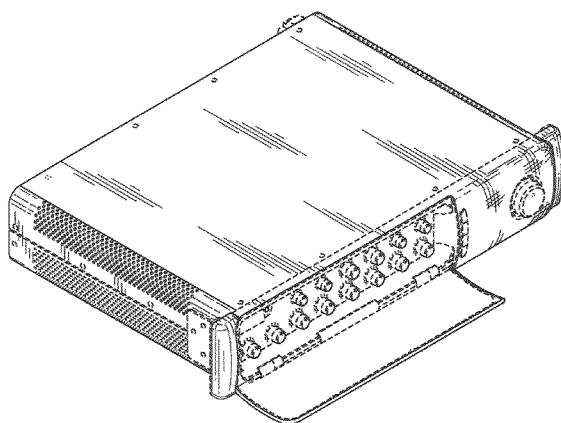

The rack ear connections on each side of the rack-mount audio component with removable ears and honeycomb pattern are symmetrical.

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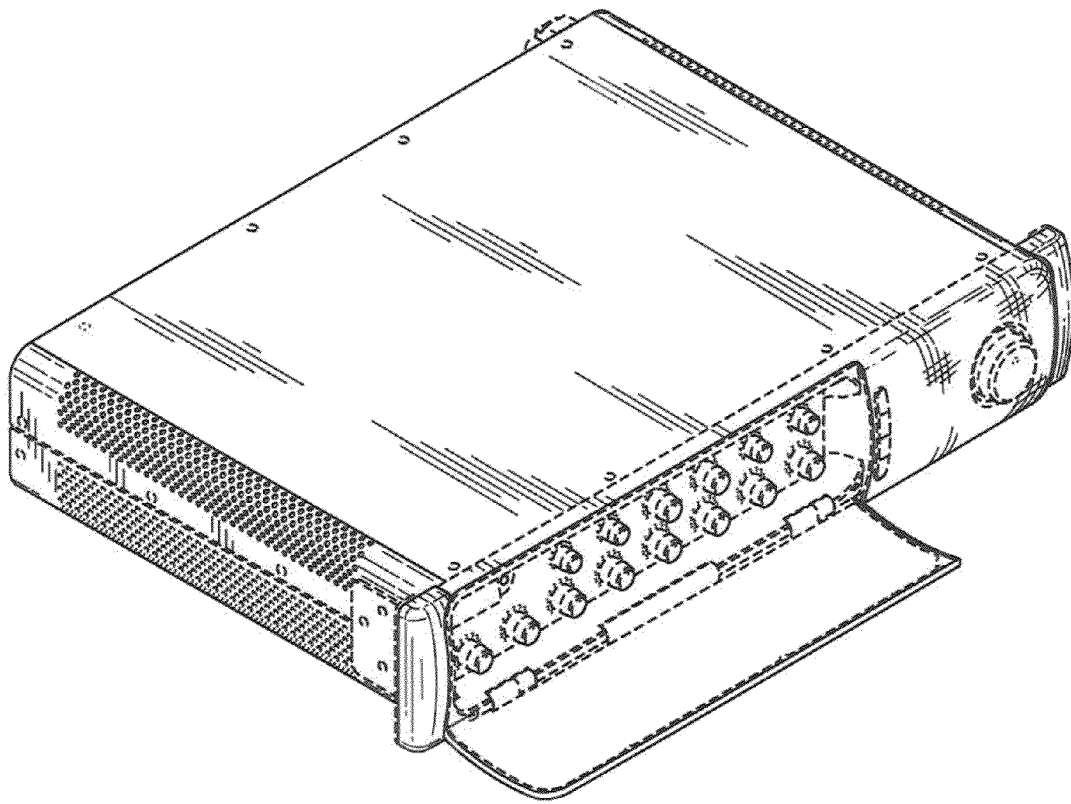

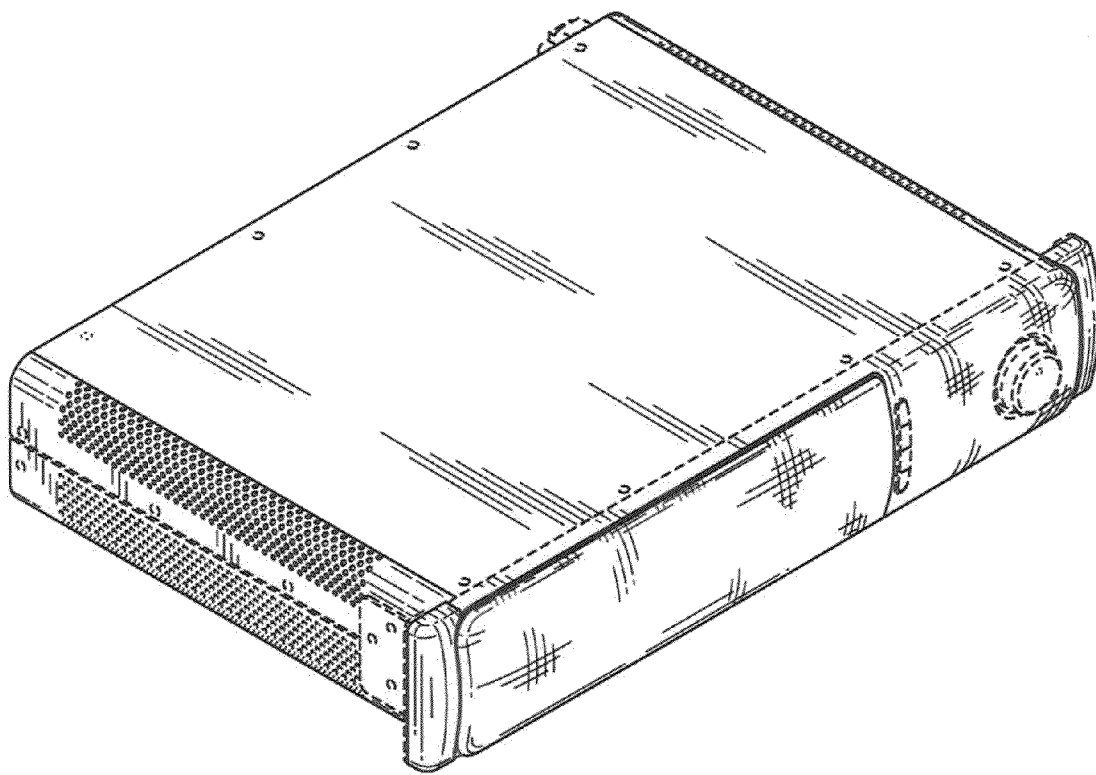

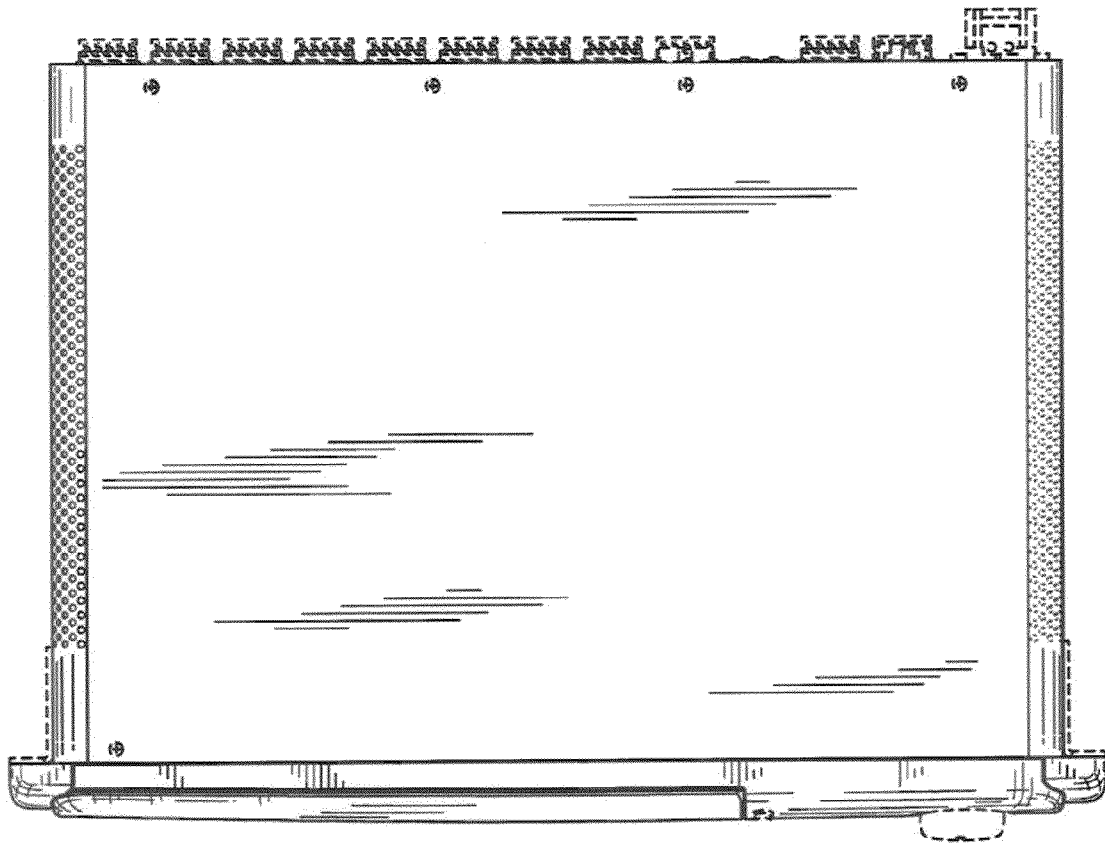

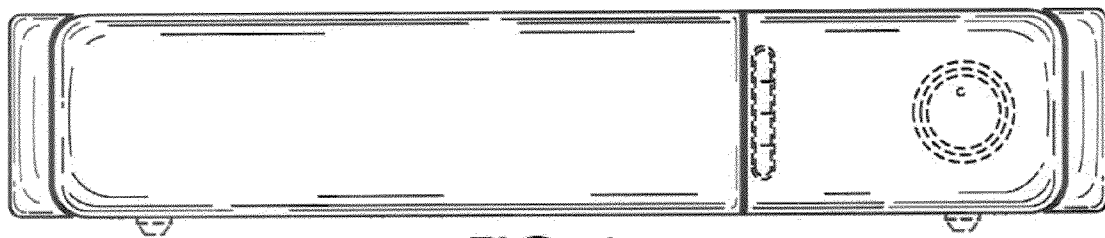

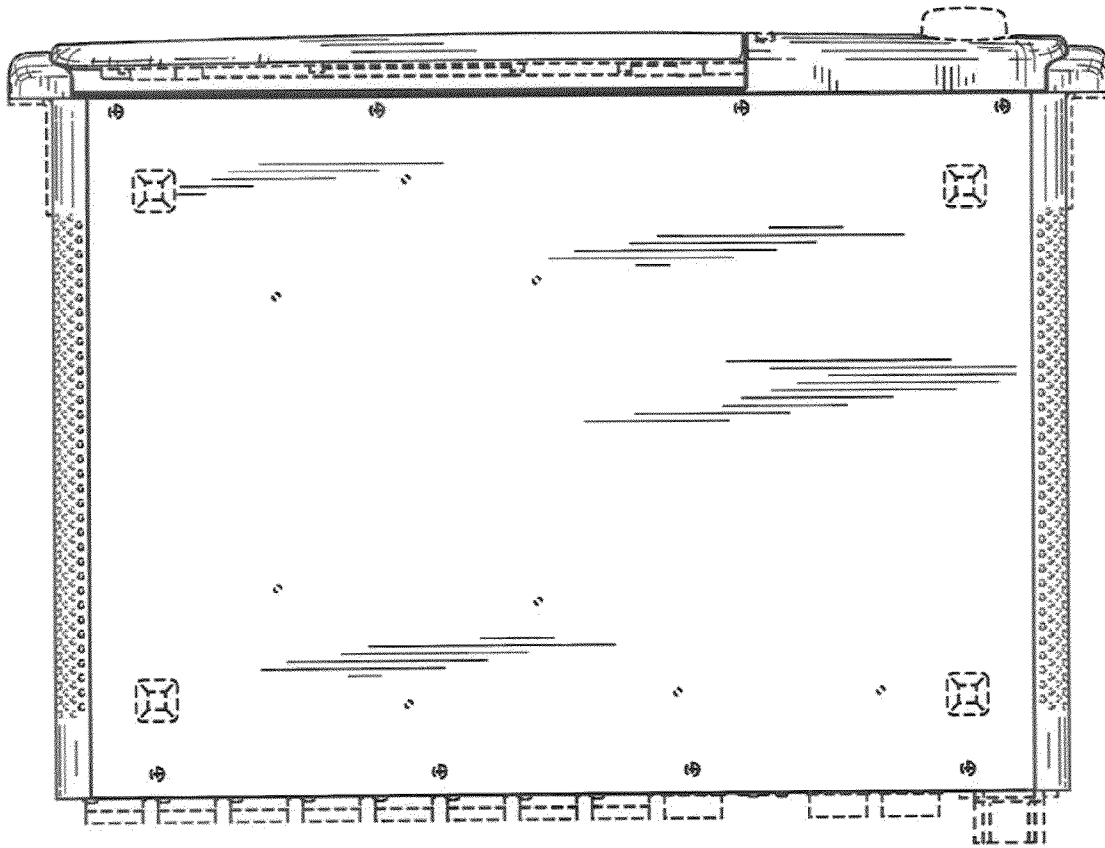

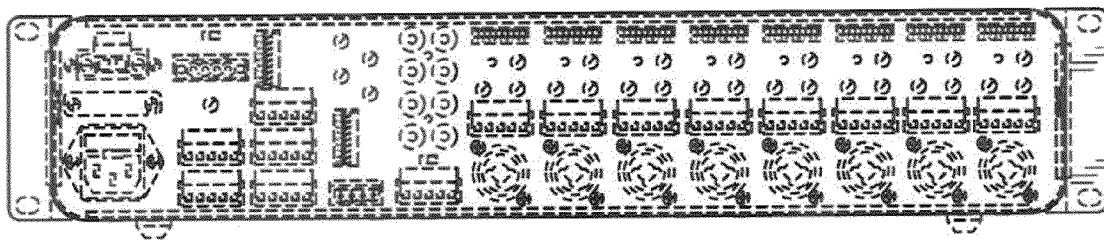

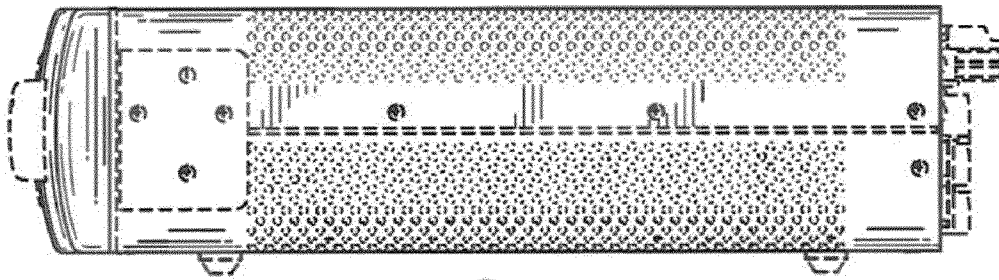

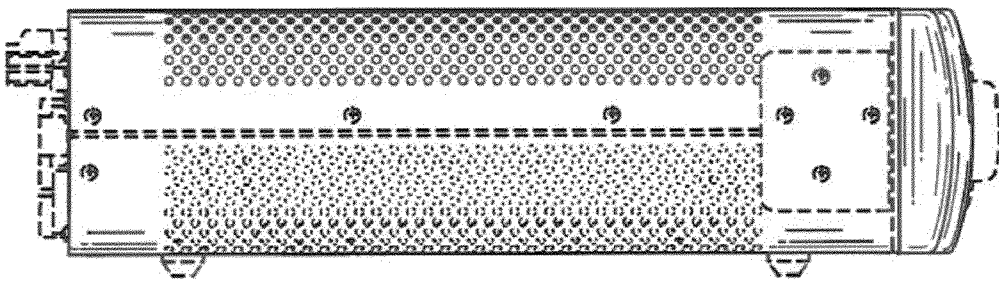

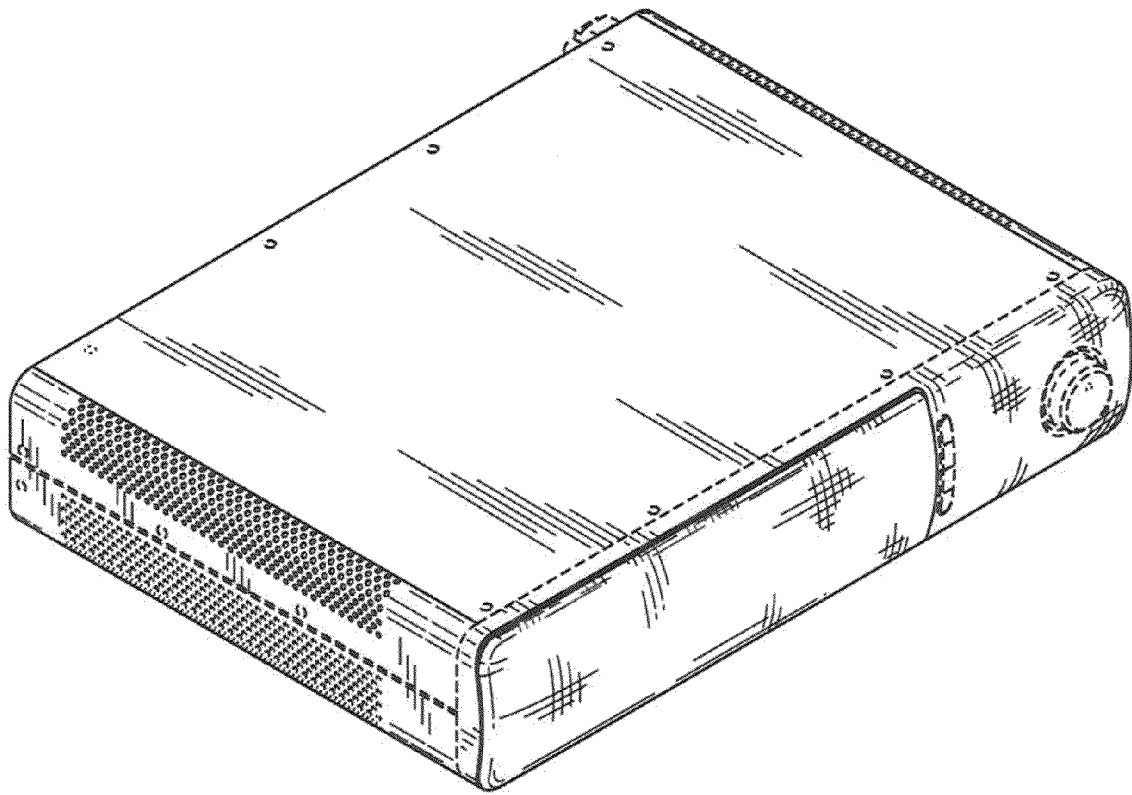
