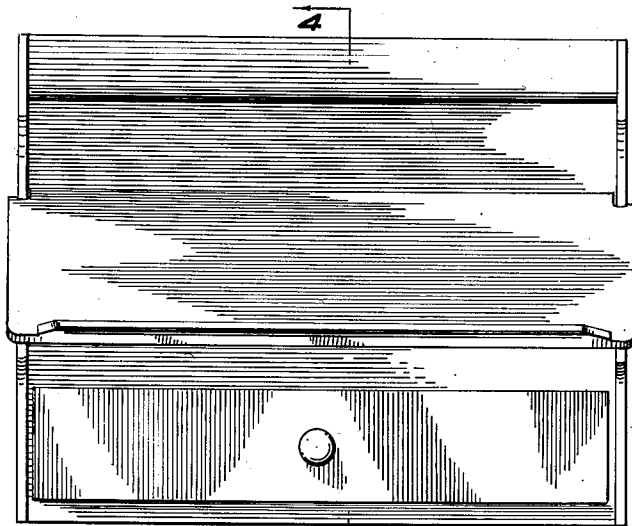

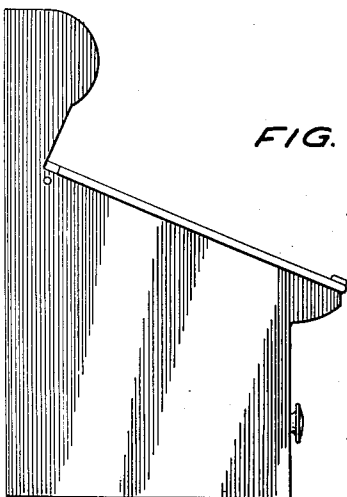

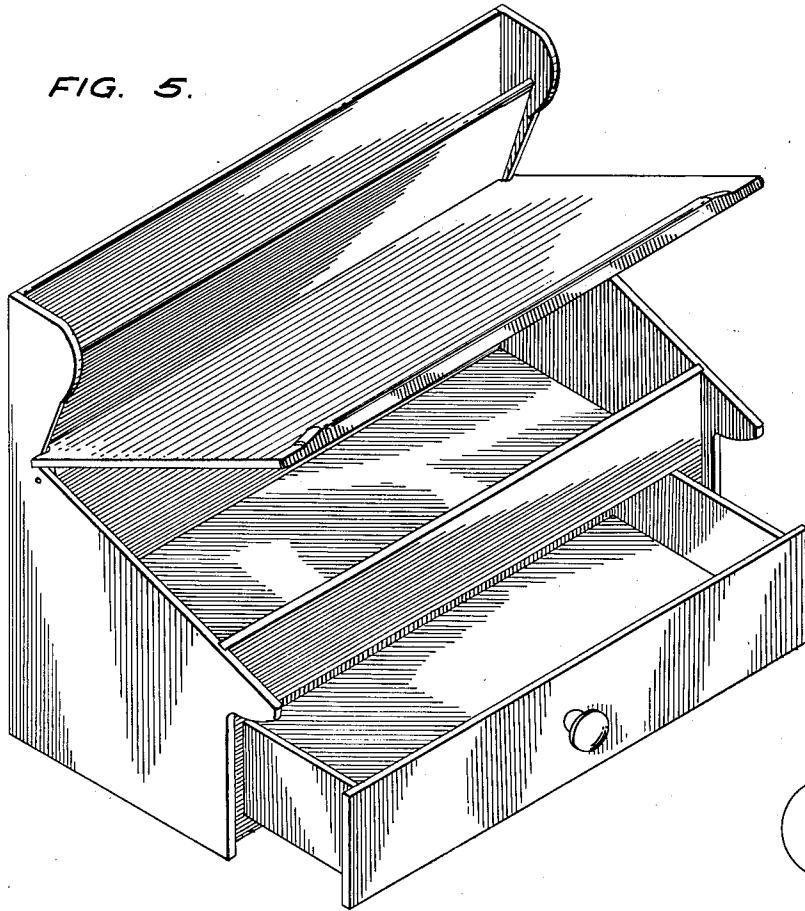
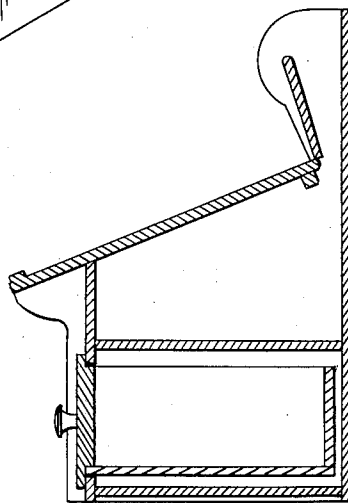

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William F. Wadsworth, a citizen of the United States, residing at North Merrick, in the county of Nassau and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Wall Desk, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a wall desk, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a front elevational view;

Figure 3 is an end view;

Figure 4 is a sectional view taken along the line 4-4 of Figure 2; and

Figure 5 is an isometric view showing the desk top partly lifted and the desk drawer partly withdrawn.
