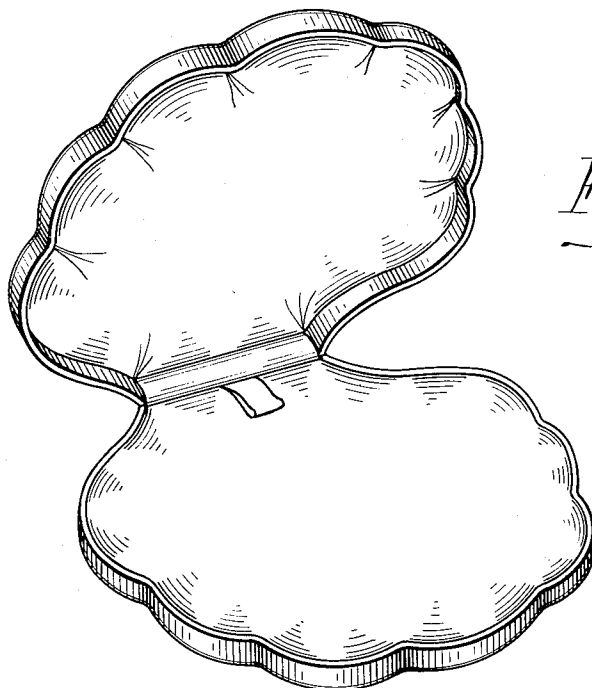

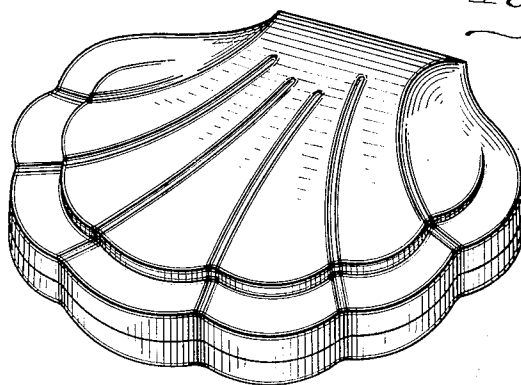

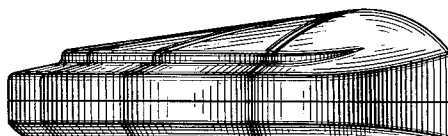

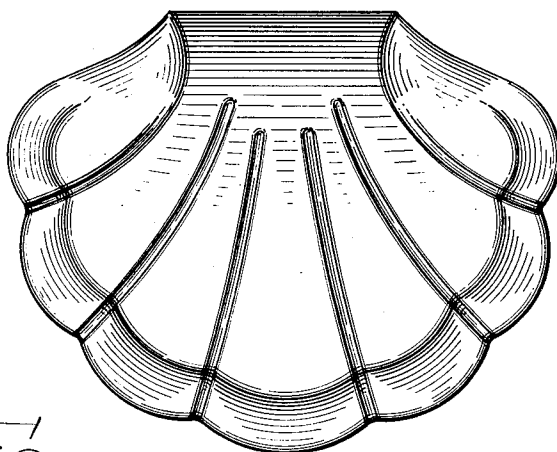

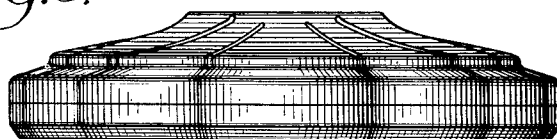
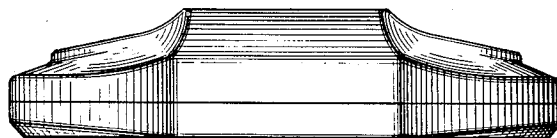

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Frank M. Bedinger, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook, State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Jewelry Box, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Figure 1 is a perspective view of the jewelry box in open position and showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a perspective view of the jewelry box in closed position;

Figure 3 is a side elevational view of the jewelry box;

Figure 4 is a top plan view of the jewelry box;

Figure 5 is a front elevational view of the jewelry box; and

Figure 6 is a rear elevational view of the jewelry box.

The ornamental design for a jewelry box, substantially as shown.
